INTRODUCTION & SCOPE OF WORK

Introduction

WBSWAN (West Bengal State Wide Area Network) is operational since 2001 connecting all District Head Quarters with State Head Quarter at Writers' Buildings with the funding from Government of West Bengal. Departments like Finance (Dist. Treasuries), Commercial Taxes, Police started using WBSWAN backbone since 2002 for accessing applications at their respective central servers at Kolkata, apart from regular video conferencing among the State (Writers' Buildings) and district headquarters. It is a triple play backbone network and information highway of the State Government for carrying out e-Governance activities through seamless data, voice and video communications among the Government Departments / Institutions / Head Ouarters / Offices.

In 2004, Department of Information Technology (DIT, GOI) under the Ministry of IT, Govt of India embarked on a countrywide e-governance Action Plan (NeGP). The primary vision of NeGP was to make "All Government services accessible to the common man in his locality, throughout his life through a Onestop-shop ensuring efficiency, transparency & reliability at affordable costs." NeGP constituted of three core projects of State Wide Area Network (SWAN), State Data Centre (SDC) and Citizen Service Centers (CSC) to be established in every State.

For establishment of an inter-operable and uniform SWAN architecture in all states, DIT had laid down certain basic guidelines outlining the core service delivery model.

As a part of National e-Governance Action Plan later in 2005, WBSWAN has been extended up to the block level. Administrative Approval obtained from Deity, GoI for Connectivity upto all Blocks of West Bengal over Terrestrial Leased Circuits from BSNL with minimum 2 Mbps Bandwidth for any link. The project was implemented in PPP model with sanctioned fund outlay of Rs 66.93 crores including operation and maintenance for 5 years. The Network was built by creating 426 POPs (Points of Presence) with BSNL Leased circuits linking 341 Block Head Quarters (BHQs), 65 Sub-division Head Quarters, 18 District Head Quarters, Writers' Building and 1 State Head Quarter (located at Monibhandar 3rd Floor, Webel Bhavan, Block-EP&GP, Sector-V, Salt Lake, Kolkata – 700091). The implementation was completed in December 2009 and it is operational since then. Later 4 more district headquarters have been added and number of WBSWAN POPs at present is 430 after addition of 4 new districts. Currently M/s Webel Mediatronics Limited is acting as the Network Operator for WBSWAN. Additionally L&LR and IGR Departments have connected their offices (approx. 700) horizontally over WBSWAN for providing G2C services through online applications like e-Bhuchitra and e-Nathikaran. About 500 such offices are connected using BSNL leased circuits and rest of the offices are connected over LAN.

SWAN (State Wide Area Network) is envisaged as the converged backbone network for data, voice and video communications throughout the State and is to be designed to cater to the information communication requirements of all the state government entities. Key focus of the SWAN project is on establishment of a secure information highway with high availability for service delivery.

The SWAN deployment is taking place both vertically and horizontally. The Project: WBSWAN expansion is mandated to spread the main SWAN backbone vertically connecting the State Head quarters with the district head quarters which in turn are connected to constituent Sub divisions down to block headquarters. The various state offices at all these three tiers proposed to be connected horizontally with the closest respective PoPs to be taken up as independent project.

DIT, GoWB has appointed M/S Webel Technology Limited and subsequently in 2008 the parent organization, M/S West Bengal Electronics Industry Development Corporation (WBEIDC – commonly referred as WEBEL) as the Implementing Agency for this project. However as per order and circular of Finance Department, GoWB, dated -- March 2017, Webel Technology Limited (WTL) has become the State Implementing Agency (SIA) of WBSWAN with effect from 01.06.2017 under the administrative control of

Personnel and Administrative Reforms and e-Governance Department, Govt. of West Bengal. Accordingly WTL will coordinate with all the stake holders for smooth execution and running of the project.

The network is supposed to provide high uptime, redundancy, backup etc. guided by stipulated Service Level criteria to be signed between the Network Operator and SIA (Webel Technology Limited) to ensure that the desired service levels are maintained. The quarterly revenue payment for the Operational Support Services will be factored by the level of performance against the agreed performance parameters outlined in the SLA. The payment will be adjusted as per stated Penalty clause, if applicable.

WTL, on behalf of the Department of Personnel and Administrative Reforms and e-Governance, GoWB has signed a separate agreement with the BSNL for ensuing high availability of the Leased Circuits and Multiprotocol Label Switching (MPLS) circuits. The Uptime and other performance criteria related to the Leased circuits / MPLS links would be independently monitored and remedial measure / penalty as per the SLA will be levied on the Bandwidth service provider based on the performance report.

Currently, WTL is on the process to implement WBSWAN Technology Refresh program in order to upgrade most of the existing equipments at all tiers to cope up with the increasing demand for network bandwidth, latest infrastructure, standards and features, which would be seamlessly integrated with the existing infrastructure.

The payment would be released on certification of proper health of the equipments/ Leased & MPLS Circuits and the achieved service level respectively from an independent agency. The independent agency hereafter termed as the Third Party Agency (TPA) would be appointed by WTL, on behalf of the Department of Personnel and Administrative Reforms and e-Governance, GoWB through the response to the RFP. The present RFP aims at the selection of the Third Party Agency for monitoring and auditing the Network performance through tender process from the shortlisted DIT, (GOI) empanelled agencies. The TPA will constantly monitor the network performance and submit the performance statistics of both the Network operator and the Bandwidth Service provider against the performance level stated in the respective SLA.

The detailed scope of work for the TPA and the proposed availability of services are detailed in the subsequent sections for ready reference.

Terms and Definitions

- 1. "Authorized Representative" shall mean any person authorized by either of the parties.
- 2. "Band Width Service Provider" terrestrial leased circuits and MPLS circuits for WBSWAN is provided by BSNL who would offer SLA for OFC and MLLN terminated circuits.
- 3. "Bidder" means any firm offering the solution(s), service(s) and /or materials required in the RFP. The word Bidder when used in the pre award period shall be synonymous with Bidder, and when used after award of the Contract shall mean the successful Bidder or Vendor with whom Government of West Bengal signs the agreement for rendering of services for SWAN.
- 4. "BOOT model" means Build Own Operate and Transfer (BOOT) model.
- 5. "Contract" is used synonymously with Agreement.
- 6. "**Default Notice**" shall mean the written notice of Default of the Agreement issued by one Party to the other in terms hereof.
- 7. "Final Acceptance Test (FAT)" means the acceptance testing of the network including equipment at SHQ, all DHQs, all SDHQs/ BLOCKs.
- 8. **"Fraudulent Practice"** means a misrepresentation of facts in order to influence a procurement process or the execution of a Contract and includes collusive practice among Bidders (prior to or after Bid submission) designed to establish Bid prices at artificial non-competitive levels and to deprive the Government of West Bengal of the benefits of free and open competition.
- 9. "GoI" shall stand for the Government of India.
- 10. "GoWB" shall stand for the Government of West Bengal.

- 11. "Implementation Period" shall mean the period from the date of signing of the Agreement and up to the completion of time period of contract.
- 12. "ITIL" means Information Technology Infrastructure Library (ITIL)
- 13. "Law" shall mean any Act, notification, bye law, rules and regulations, directive, ordinance, order or instruction having the force of law enacted or issued by the Central Government and/ or the Government of West Bengal or any other Government or regulatory authority or political subdivision of government agency.
- 14. **"LOI"** means issuing of Letter of Intent which shall constitute the intention of the Tenderer to place the Purchase Order with the successful bidder.
- 15. "Network" means LAN or WAN which would constitute a part of WBSWAN.
- 16. "Network Operator" refers to M/S Webel Mediatronics Limited, operating and maintaining the WBSWAN at present.
- 17. "Partial Acceptance Test (PAT)" means the provisional acceptance testing of all PoPs (SHQ, DHQs, SDHQs and BHQs).
- 18. "Party" means Government of West Bengal or Bidder, individually and "Parties" mean Government of West Bengal and Bidder, collectively.
- 19. "PoP" refers to Point of Presence with respect to SWAN setup in State.
- 20. "Remote Office" means the office located at a distance of more than 1Km from the respective Centre.
- 21. "Request for Proposal (RFP)", means this detailed notification seeking a set of solution(s), services(s), materials and/or any combination of them.
- 22. "Requirements" shall mean and include schedules, details, description, statement of technical data, performance characteristics, standards (Indian as well as International) as applicable and specified in the RFP.
- 23. "Service" means provision of Contracted service as per this RFP.
- 24. "SHQ" means the POP at State head quarter being located at WBEIDC premises at Salt Lake, Kolkata.
- 25. "Site" shall mean the location(s) for which the Contract has been issued and where the service shall be provided as per agreement.
- 26. "SLA" means Service Level Agreement
- 27. "State" shall mean the state of West Bengal.
- 28. "SWAN" shall mean State Wide Area Network.
- 29. "Third Party Agency" (TPA) means the successful Bidder, appointed by Government of West Bengal for monitoring the SWAN during commissioning and operation after execution of the relevant agreement between the implementing agency (WBEIDC) and the successful bidder.
- 30. "**Termination Notice**" means the written notice of termination of the Agreement issued by one Party to the other in terms hereof.
- 31. "WBEIDC (Webel)", a Government of West Bengal Undertaking is the previous Implementing Agency for the WBSWAN project as designated by DIT, GoI.
- 32. "WBSWAN" means West Bengal State Wide Area Network as constructed in 2001 and expanded subsequently.
- 33. "WTL" or Webel Technology Limited, a Government of West Bengal Undertaking is the current Implementing Agency for the WBSWAN project.
- 34. "WBSWAN Technology Refresh", a program to replace the outdated systems with the latest one to improve performance and to be in line of the current technology trends.

Third Party Auditor (TPA)

TPA is envisaged as an agency that will independently monitor the various functionality of the WBSWAN and appraise WTL about the adherence to various service level parameters by both the Network operator and Bandwidth service provider. TPA is required to provide support for entire contract period with the state. WTL will release payment to various agencies on correlating various reports submitted by the TPA and the operators.

In 2008, DIT, GoI has evaluated the capabilities of various bidders through a national level bid processing and have short listed six(6) reputed organizations to be entrusted as the TPAs for various SWANs being built as part of NeGP. This RFP is going to be the base NIT document for a tender for selecting the TPA agency for WBSWAN for next 3 years from the list of MeitY empanelled agencies / agencies having previous experience as serving SWAN TPA in India.

The TPA need to deploy dedicated man power primarily at the SHQ POP along with necessary tools to monitor various performance parameters. The TPA will need access to NMS and related systems at the SHQ POP. Prior to their response to this RFP the bidder should do an in-depth study of the Network infrastructure, System deployment including the various security systems and appliance, monitoring system etc as available in the WBSWAN and described as part of this document. For this, the intended bidder may visit the SHQ NOC and/or any WBSWAN POP with prior intimation to the WBSWAN team. Based on the study the bidder should indicate their proposed monitoring system in their technical solution and presentation and its deployment underlining the access needed to the WBSWAN. WTL will review with the bidder the requirement and arrange for the mutually agreed access. If there is any additional requirement of monitoring tool (in addition to existing CA NMS), the same should be indicated in the bid response.

The State/WTL shall provide office space at the SHQ location with facilities like furniture, power connection, telephone/fax connection etc.

In addition to the SHQ location a further team shall be required to undertake the site visits as per the requirements of the RFP. As a response to the bid the bidder should identify and commit the size of the team to be deployed for the WBSWAN and for the 24 X 7 monitoring team at the SHQ POP¹. During the tenure of the contract the team members such committed will be deployed exclusively for this project and cannot be shared by the TPA for other activities. In the event of non-availability of the committed manpower on account of attrition or other cause, the TPA must inform the same in writing to WTL with a suitable replacement person with equivalent qualification and experience. The replacement must be done within 5 working days of attrition.

The equipment for TPA's team (like laptop/ workstation, printer etc.) shall be TPA's responsibility. However in the event additional monitoring tool is required, the same should be mentioned separately and should be included in the price bid .Procurement of the same shall be the sole responsibility of the TPA.

Any additional equipment deployed during the period of this contract beyond those mentioned in this document and need to be monitored, the TPA will be paid additional charges as per mutual agreement between the State and TPA. In the event additional POPs are created and needs to be monitored, the per PoP charges as quoted for the particular class of the POP shall apply.

TPA Scope of Work

Third Party Audit shall include monitoring the performance of the WBSWAN with a view to ensure desired Quality of Service (QoS) by the Network Operator and Bandwidth service provider, as defined in the respective SLA's, signed between the State Government, and Bandwidth Service Provider/ Network Operator. The following guidelines define the broad areas of work, which TPA shall perform for a period of 3 (Three) years from 1 July 2018.

To understand the project TPA would be required to

a) Study the contract signed between WBEIDC/WTL and the Network Operator (Webel Mediatronics Limited – WML at present) and Bandwidth Service Provider (BSNL).

The committed manpower should be on the direct payrolls of the TPA. The service cannot be provided through sub-contractors or ASPs.

- b) Study the network architecture & design and the services envisaged.
- Review communication process among the stakeholders (State government Implementation agency (WTL), Network Operator, Bandwidth service provider and Dept. of PAR -GoWB).
- d) Develop frameworks and procedures for audit.
- e) Study the functionality of the Network Monitoring System (NMS) installed for WBSWAN and identifies the gaps, if any. In the event the bidder envisages a requirement for additional module/tool including additional monitoring software, same should be mentioned separately and should be included separately in the price bid²
- f) Review of the escalation mechanisms being followed to resolve any issues between the State Implementing Agency and the Network Operator related to WBSWAN.
- g) Technology Refresh for the entire WBSWAN infrastructure across all PoPs involving replacement of most of the old hardware / software with latest products is under execution by WTL's System Integration partner M/s Bharti Airtel in close coordination with the Network Operator (WML) with effect from 2nd May 2018. The project is expected to be over by 30th June 2018.

Acceptance Test (PAT, FAT)

- a) TPA shall review the detailed acceptance test plan (PAT and FAT) in consultation with WTL after taking into account any comments/suggestions of P&AR & e-Governance Department. All hardware / software products installed across all WBSWAN PoPs under the Technology Refresh project being executed by M/s Bharti Airtel will come under the scope of PAT and FAT. However, the Horizontal POPs are excluded from the scope of PAT/FAT.
- b) TPA would also conduct audit of the processes, plans and results of the Acceptance Tests carried out by the Network Operator. TPA would issue certificate of completion of Acceptance Tests for PoPs for which TPA shall verify availability of all the defined services as per the contract signed between Network operator and State/Implementing Agency. Network operator along with the Technology Refresh vendor M/s Bharti Airtel shall be required to demonstrate all services/features/functionalities as mentioned in respective contracts/SLAs signed with them.

Inventory

- a) TPA audit would include verification of completeness of bill of material at each PoP.
- b) TPA audit would include review that all hardware and software items have been installed at the sites as per the contract.
- c) TPA audit would include maintenance of an inventory register to have PoP wise equipment list, including hardware and software. TPA audit would also include updating inventory registry in the event of any changes in the inventory.

Inventory Audit is to be performed **annually** and the relevant changes in the year of the audit shall be recorded. Inventory Details shall be provided by the State and TPA shall maintain a record at its end, which shall be updated by TPA based on information provided by the State. Also, the verification will be done through tools and through site visits as explained in RFP.

The TPA would certify through NMS the health of each equipment deployed as per the inventory register on a yearly basis starting with the existing and/or refreshed inventory lists.

These exercises would include review of documentation, physical verification of equipment @40% annually (@10% quarterly) on sample basis and reports generated for the total deployed material using NMS. However, for equipment deployed at the horizontal offices, inventory may be checked remotely and physical verification is not necessary.

² The bid will be evaluated including the price of the additional tools and if the bid is most responsive the composite order will be placed. However the separately mentioned tools/ software etc will be the property of the GoWB at the end of the contract period

SLA Monitoring Audit

SLA monitoring would include audit of the performance of network. Network includes the components provided and/or operated by the Network Operator and bandwidth provisioned by the Bandwidth Service Provider. The performance reports, frequency of them and the items covered therein which will be provided by the TPA should match the requirement of WTL in order to monitor the performance of both the contractors (Partners) as per the respective SLA agreements.

Subsequently, TPA would also carry out the following tasks:

- a) TPA audit would include preparation of templates for reports to be submitted by Network Operator to TPA / WTL and report to be submitted by the TPA to the State/WTL. TPA shall also tabulate measurable parameters as defined in the respective SLAs with the Network Operator and bandwidth service provider.
- b) TPA shall review the configuration/deployment parameters of the NMS and the process followed to ensure that the reports generated are authentic.
- c) TPA would proactively convey to the stakeholders any concerns based on the information generated using NMS.
- d) TPA would also undertake proactive monitoring of the links provided by the bandwidth service provider based on the SLA signed by the bandwidth service provider. The Agency shall submit reports on the same to the government who would use these reports for making the payments to the bandwidth service provider.
- e) TPA would provide quarterly certification of network availability and availability of the services specially the Video conferencing³ and perform penalty computation for the calculation of quarterly payments to be released to the Network Operator/Bandwidth Service Provider (BSNL) as per the SLAs and payment conditions mentioned in the agreements signed between Network Operator/Bandwidth Service Provider (BSNL) and the State/WTL (on Quarterly basis).
- f) TPA audit would also include site inspection to verify those parameters of the SLA, which cannot be monitored using NMS e.g. Video Conferencing. These site visits would be done for at least 10% of the sites (at each network tier) per quarter.

Usage Audit

- a) TPA would appraise WTL/GoWB about the health of the network through reports indicating the application wise bandwidth utilization, overall bandwidth utilization, scalability requirements as per the current and envisaged State level applications etc.
- b) Only the overall Recommendation for Expansion is covered under the purview of this contract. For detailed activities like designing, BoM, specifications etc. the State is expected to engage the concerned Agency separately.

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Special mention of performance of the video conferencing system has been provided for in the SLA with the network operator

Security Audit

- a) TPA would perform security audit of WBSWAN as per the Guidelines issued by the Department of IT, Govt. of India/ Cert-In and submit recommendations to the State indicating the risk elements in the network operations and the safeguard steps
- b) The Agency would perform the penetration testing and vulnerability testing on the SWAN network.
- c) The Agency would review the rules and policies for network components such as firewall, UTM, IDS, IPS, etc.
- d) The Agency would review the network security policy of the State and suggest recommendations if any.
- e) The Agency would review the policy of granting access to the SWAN network.
- f) The Agency would conduct the Security Audit and submit reports on half yearly basis.

Helpdesk & User feedback

- a) TPA audit would include review of the helpdesk setup by the Network Operator and the Agency would submit a Quarterly Report with recommendations to the State/WTL.
- b) The Agency would review the mechanism of obtaining user feedback on quality of service & post analysis of the same, and would submit a report with recommendations to the State/WTL. This task would be done on a yearly basis.

Exit Process support

This role is envisaged with the objective of ensuring preparedness of the State at all the time for any eventuality resulting in termination of contract. TPA audit includes support/advice in the event of exit of the Network Operator. The Agency would:

- a) Review the exit process as per the contract.
- b) Advise WTL on documentation, process and procedures necessary for taking over the network from the Network Operator.
- c) Provide advisory support during the transition period from the current Network Operator to the new operator.
- d) Conduct audit readiness of the State/WTL for such an eventuality on a Yearly basis.

WTL, in consultation with Department of P&AR & e-Governance, Govt. of West Bengal, would institute a separate audit by an Agency at a National level (e.g. STQC) which would carry out risk based sample audit of the methodology, process and documentation adopted by the TPA in order to ensure that the processes adopted by the Agency is of international standard. The identification of Agency by the GoWB would be based upon parameters such as past record of the Agency, previous observations of the audit, GoWB Feedback, Amount of QGR to be paid etc. TPA would undergo one such audit in a year. However, this would be decided by Dept. of P&AR & e-Governance, Govt. of West Bengal.

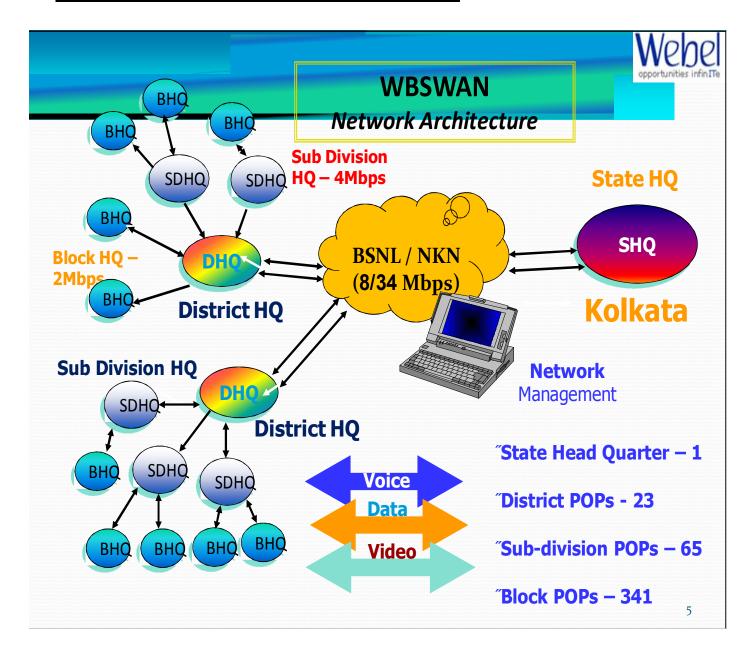

In this document, the following terms shall have following respective meanings:

- "Acceptance Test Document" means a document, which defines procedures for testing the functioning of installed system. The document will be finalized with the contractor within 7 days of issuance of the Letter of Award/Confirm Work Order.
- "Agreement" means the Agreement to be signed between the successful bidder and WTL including all attachments, appendices, all documents incorporated by reference thereto together with any subsequent modifications, the RFP, the bid offer, the acceptance and all related correspondences, clarifications, presentations.
- "Bidder" means any firm offering the solution(s), service(s) and /or materials required in the RFP. The word Bidder when used in the pre award period shall be synonymous with Bidder, and when used after award of the Contract shall mean the successful Bidder with whom WTL signs the agreement for supply, install, commission and render services for the systems.
- "Contract" is used synonymously with Agreement.
- "Contract Price" means the price to be paid to the Contractor for providing the Solution, in accordance with the payment terms.
- "Contractor" means the Bidder whose bid to perform the Contract has been accepted by Tender Committee and is named as such in the Letter of Award.
- "Default Notice" shall mean the written notice of Default of the Agreement issued by one Party to the other.
- "Fraudulent Practice" means a misrepresentation of facts in order to influence a procurement process or the execution of a Contract and includes collusive practice among Bidders (prior to or after Bid submission) designed to establish Bid prices at artificial noncompetitive levels and to deprive the benefits of free and open competition.
- "Good Industry Practice" shall mean the exercise of that degree of skill, diligence and prudence which would reasonably and ordinarily be expected from a reasonably skilled and experienced Operator engaged in the same type of undertaking under the same or similar circumstances.
- "Government" / "Gov. of W. Bengal" means the Government of West Bengal.
- "GoI" shall stand for the Government of India.
- "GoWB" means Government of West Bengal
- "WTL" means Webel Technology Limited a Gov. of W. Bengal undertaking.
- "Personnel" means persons hired by the Bidder as employees and assigned to the performance of the Infrastructure Solution or any part thereof.
- "Project"
- "Services" means the work to be performed by the Bidder pursuant to this Contract, as described in the detailed Scope of Work.

"Similar Nature" includes

"Interest rate" means "364 days Government of India (GoI) Treasury Bills" rate.

"Law" shall mean any Act, notification, bye law, rules and regulations, directive, ordinance, order or instruction having the force of law enacted or issued by the Central Government and/or the Government of West Bengal or any other Government or regulatory authority or political subdivision of government agency.

"LOI" means issuing of Letter of Intent shall constitute the intention of the WTL to place the Purchase Order with the successful bidder.

"Period of Agreement" means 3 years from the date of Final acceptance.

"Termination Notice" means the written notice of termination of the Agreement issued by WTL.

2. PRE BID MEETING

Pre Bid Meeting will be held on 30.05.2018 at 11.30 hrs at premises of WTL. Bidder can send their queries as per format (Section - K) to Manager (Purchase) (arunava.saha@wtl.co.in) and copy to Mr. Jadugopal Mondal ((jadugopalm@wb.gov.in) / Ms. Soma Dey (soma@wb.gov.in) / Ms. Anita Dey (wtladety@gmail.com). Only the queries received within the stipulated date prior to the Pre Bid Meeting will be answered. The entrance to the Pre Bid Meeting will be limited to two persons per bidder and carrying valid authorization letter on official letter head bearing company seal.

3. COST OF BIDDING

The bidder shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of the bid and WTL will no case be responsible for those costs regardless of the conduct or outcome of the bidding process.

4. BID DOCUMENT

Bidder is expected to examine all instructions, forms, terms and requirement in the bid document. The invitation to bid together with all its attachment thereto shall be considered to be read, understood and accepted by the bidder unless deviations are specifically stated in the seriatim by the bidder. Failure to furnish all information required by the bid document or a bid not substantially responsive to the bid document in every respect may result of the bid.

5. AMENDMENT OF BID DOCUMENT

At any time prior to the deadline for submission of proposals, WTL reserves the right to add/modify/delete any portion of this document by issuance of an Corrigendum, which would be published on the website and will also be made available to the all the Bidder who have been issued the tender document. The Corrigendum shall be binding on all bidders and will form part of the bid documents.

6. MODIFICATION AND WITHDRAWAL OF BIDS

The bidder cannot modify or withdraw its bid after submission.

7. LANGUAGE OF BID & CORRESPONDENCE

The proposal will be prepared by the Bidder in English language only. All the documents relating to the proposal (including brochures) supplied by the firm should also be in English, and the correspondence between the Bidder & WTL will be in English language only. The correspondence by fax/E-mail must be subsequently confirmed by a duly signed formal copy.

8. EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT (EMD)

The firm shall furnish an EMD of Rs.3,00,000.00 (Rupees Three lakhs only) in the form of a demand draft from a Scheduled Bank payable at Kolkata and in favour of Webel Technology Limited. Any bid not

accompanied with the EMD shall be rejected. The validity of EMD instrument will be initially 3 months, have to extend, if required.

9. FORFEITURE OF EMD

EMD made by Bidder may be forfeited under the following conditions:

If Bidder withdraws the proposal before the expiry of validity period.

During the evaluation process, if a Bidder indulges in any such activity as would jeopardize the process, the decision of WTL regarding forfeiture of EMD shall be final and shall not be called upon question under any circumstances.

If Bidder violates any of the provisions of the terms and conditions of the proposal.

In the case of a successful Bidder, if Bidder fails to:

- a) Accept the work order along with the terms and conditions.
- b) Furnish performance security.
- c) Violates any of the work conditions of this proposal or indulges in any such activities as would jeopardize the work.
- d) Submitting false/misleading information/declaration/documents/proof/etc.

The decision of WTL regarding forfeiture of EMD shall be final and shall not be called upon to question under any circumstances, besides, forfeiture of EMD even the Bidder will be deferred from participating in any job for a period of one year.

10. FORMS AND FORMATS

The various inputs for the Techno Commercial as Financial Bids are to be submitted in the format specified. The bidder shall use the form, wherever specified, to provide relevant information. If form does not provide space for any required information, space at the end of the form or additional sheets shall be used to convey the said information. For all other cases, the bidder shall design a form to hold the required information.

11. LACK OF INFORMATION TO BIDDER

The bidder shall be deemed to have carefully examined the Bid document to his entire satisfaction. Any lack of information shall not relieve the bidder of his responsibility to fulfill his obligation under the bid. If bidder has any queries relating to bid document then he can send the queries before the Pre Bid Meeting.

12. CONTRACT EXECUTION

On receipt of the Letter of Award the contractor should submit a Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG) equivalent to 10% of the total contract value within three weeks from the date of receipt of Letter of Award/Order. The PBG should be valid for six month more than the warranty period. All delivery of the material will have to be completed within 45 days from the date of acceptance of contract and the contractor has to ensure all activities leading to the commissioning of the contract to be completed within 90 days from the date of award. Subsequent to the award of contract, the contractor will have to arrange for the requisite material as per BOM.

13. PERIOD OF CONTRACT

Three years from the date commencement of job.

14. LIQUIDATED DAMAGE

In the event Bidder fails to provide the Services in accordance with the Service Standard, Bidder shall be liable for penalty as per the terms and conditions of Service Level Agreements (SLAs) to be agreed between the TPA and the administration of GoWB. WTL/Department is entitled to withhold (deduct) from the payment due or the Performance Bank Guarantee the liquidated damages that have become due.

15. LIABILITY

In case of a default on bidder's part or other liability, WTL shall be entitled to recover damages from the Contractor. In each such instance, regardless of the basis on which WTL is entitled to claim damages from the Contractor (including fundamental breach, negligence, misrepresentation, or other contract or tort claim), Contractor shall be liable for no more than:

- Payment referred to in the Patents and Copyrights clause.
- Liability for bodily injury (including death) or damage to real property and tangible personal property limited to that cause by the Contractor's negligence.
- As to any other actual damage arising in any situation involving nonperformance by Contractor
 pursuant to or in any way related to the subject of this Agreement, the charge paid by WTL for the
 individual product or Service that is the subject of the Claim. However, the contractor shall not be
 liable for
- For any indirect, consequential loss or damage, lost profits, third party loss or damage to property or loss of or damage to data.

For any direct loss or damage that exceeds the total payment for Contract Price made or expected to be made to the Contractor hereunder.

16. SUSPENSION OF WORK

WTL shall have the power at any time and from time to time by notice to the Contractor to delay or suspend the progress of the work or any part of the work due to any other adequate reasons and on receipt of such notice the contractor shall forthwith suspend further progress of the work until further notice from WTL. The Contractor shall recommence work immediately after receiving a notice to do so from WTL. The whole or any part of the time lost for such delay or suspension shall, if WTL in its absolute discretion thinks fit, but not otherwise, be added to the time allowed for completion.

17. TERMS OF PAYMENT

Payment terms will be on back-to-back basis, i.e., payment will be made only on receipt of payment from relevant customer. A scheduled payment terms depicted below:

- 1. Mobilization Advance on signing of Contract Equivalent to payment for One Quarter
- 2. End of Every Quarter (subsequent to first quarter) Payment for the Quarter

18. GOVERNING LAWS

This contract should be governed by and interpreted by Arbitration clause in accordance with Laws in force in India. The courts at Kolkata shall have exclusive jurisdiction in all matters arising under the contract. The selected vendor shall keep himself fully informed of all current national, state and municipal law and ordinances. The selected vendor shall at their own expense, obtain all necessary permits and license and pay all fees and taxes required by law. These will be selected vendor's entire obligation regarding any claim of infringement. The selected vendor hereto agrees that it shall comply with all applicable union, state and local laws, ordinances, regulations and codes in performing its obligations hereunder, including the procurement of licenses, permits certificates and payment of taxes where required. The selected vendor shall establish and maintain all proper records (particularly, but without limitation, accounting records) required by any law, code/practice of corporate policy applicable to it from time to time including records and returns as applicable under labor legislation.

19. CORRUPT OR FRAUDULENT PRATICES

The Tender Committee requires that the bidders under this Tender observe the highest standards of ethics during the procurement and execution of such contracts. For this purpose the definition of corrupt and fraudulent practices will follow the provisions of the relevant laws in force. The Tender Committee will reject a proposal for award if it detects that the bidder has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices in competing for the contract in question. The Tender Committee will declare a firm ineligible, either indefinitely or for a stated period of time, if it at any time determines that the firm has engaged in corrupt and fraudulent practices in competing for, or in executing, a contract.

20. BINDING CLAUSE

All decisions taken by the Tender Committee regarding the processing of this tender and award of contract shall be final and binding on all parties concerned. The Tender Committee reserves the right:

- To vary, modify, revise, amend or change any of the terms and conditions mentioned above and,
- To reject any or all the Tender/s without assigning any reason whatsoever thereof or to annul the bidding process and reject all bids at any time prior to award of contract, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder(s) or any obligation to inform the affected bidder(s) of the grounds for such decision.

21. WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION

In every case in which by virtue of the provision of the workmen's compensation Act 1923 or any other relevant acts and rules, compensation to a workmen employed by the contractor, is payable, then this should be done by the Contractor. If WTL is obliged to make any compensation under the said rules and acts, then the amount shall be recovered without prejudice, from the bills and due of the Contractor. WTL shall not be bound to contest any claim made against the Contractor in respect of workmen's compensation.

22. CONTRACTOR'S EMPLOYEES

The Contractor shall comply with the provision of all labour legislation including the requirement of the payment of Wage Act 1936 and the rules framed there under and modifications thereof in respect of men employed by him in carrying out the contract. The Contractor must ensure that he complies with PF, ESI regulation for all his deployed employees. The Contractor shall see that all authorized Sub Contractors under him similarly complied with the above requirement.

23. SUB-CONTRACT

The purchaser (WTL) does not recognize the existence of Sub-Contractors. The Contractor's responsibility is not transferable.

24. TERMINATION FOR DEFAULT

WTL may without prejudice to any other remedy or right of claim for breach of contract by giving not less than 30 days written notice of default sent to the contractor, terminate the order in whole or in part. If the contractor materially fails to render any or all the services within the time period specified in the contract or any extension thereof granted by WTL in writing and fails to remedy its failure within a period of thirty days after receipt of default notice from WTL. If the project (delivery, commissioning as well as warranty maintenance support is not carried out according to specification due to deficiency in service as per terms of the contract. In such case WTL will invoke the amount held back from the contractor as PBG.

25. BANKRUPTCY

If the contractor becomes bankrupt or have a receiving order made against him or compound with his creditors or being a corporation commence to be wound up, not being a voluntary winding up for the purpose only or amalgamation or reconstruction, or carry on their business under a receiver for the benefit of their creditors or any of them, WTL shall be at liberty to terminate the engagement forthwith without any notice in writing to the contractor or to the liquidator or receiver or to any person in whom the contractor may become vested and without any compensation to give such liquidator or receiver or other person the option of carrying out the engagement subject to their providing a guarantee for the due and faithful performance of the engagement up to an amount to be determined by WTL.

26. FORCE MAJEURE

It is hereby defined as any cause, which is beyond the control of the Contractor or WTL as the case may be, which such party could not foresee or with a reasonable amount of diligence could not have foreseen and which substantially affect the performance of the contract, such as

- War, Hostilities or warlike operations (whether a state of war be declared or not), invasion, act of foreign enemy and civil war.
- Rebellion, revolution, insurrection, mutiny, usurpation of civil or military, government, conspiracy, riot, civil commotion and terrorist area.
- Confiscation, nationalization, mobilization, commandeering or requisition by or under the order of
 any government or de facto authority or ruler, or any other act or failure to act of any local state or
 national government authority.

- Strike, sabotage, lockout, embargo, import restriction, port congestion, lack of usual means of public transportation and communication, industrial dispute, shipwreck, shortage of power supply epidemics, quarantine and plaque.
- Earthquake, landslide, volcanic activity, fire flood or inundation, tidal wave, typhoon or cyclone, hurricane, nuclear and pressure waves or other natural or physical disaster.

If either party is prevented, hindered or delayed from or in performing any of its obligations under the Contract by an event of Force Majeure, then it shall notify the other in writing of the occurrence of such event and the circumstances of the event of Force Majeure within fourteen days after the occurrence of such event. The party who has given such notice shall be excused from the performance or punctual performance of its obligations under the Contract for so long as the relevant event of Force Majeure continues and to the extent that such party's performance is prevented, hindered or delayed.

The party or parties affected by the event of Force Majeure shall use reasonable efforts to mitigate the effect of the event of Force Majeure upto its or their performance of the Contract and to fulfill its or their obligation under the Contract but without prejudice to either party's right to terminate the Contract.

No delay or nonperformance by either party to this Contract caused by the occurrence of any event of Force Majeure shall.

- Constitute a default or breach of the contract.
- Give rise to any claim for damages or additional cost or expense occurred by the delay or nonperformance. If, and to the extent, that such delay or nonperformance is caused by the occurrence of an event of Force Majeure.

27. INSURANCE COVERAGE

Vendor shall maintain standard forms of comprehensive insurance including liability insurance, system and facility insurance and any other insurance for the personnel, assets, data, software, etc. and submit the list of all the insured items to GoWB / WTL prior to the start of operations. Vendor shall take and keep effective all the insurances during the period of the Contract.

28. PERFORMANCE BANK GUARANTEE (PBG)

As a guarantee for timely delivery of the work as well as performance as mentioned in scope of work, from the date of final acceptance of order, the bidder will have to submit 10% of the contract value as security in the form of Performance Bank Guarantee from any nationalized bank as per format enclosed (Section – M).

29. NO WAIVER OF RIGHTS

Neither the inspection by WTL or any of their agents nor any order by WTL for payment of money or any payment for or acceptance of the whole or any part of the works by WTL, nor any extension of time, nor any possession taken by WTL shall operate as a waiver of any provision of the contract or of any power reserved to WTL, or any right to damages here in provided, nor shall any waiver of any breach in the contract be held to be a waiver of any other subsequent breach.

30. ENFORCEMENT OF TERMS

The failure of either party to enforce at any time any of the provision of this contract or any rights in respect thereto or to exercise any option here in provided shall in no way be construed to be a waiver to such provisions, rights or options or in any way to affect the validity of the contract. The exercise by either party of any of its rights herein shall not preclude or prejudice either party from exercising the same or any other right it may have hereunder.

31. PERIOD OF VALIDITY OF OFFER

For the purpose of placing the order, the proposals shall remain valid till 180 days. During the period of validity of proposals, the rates quoted shall not change. In exceptional circumstances, WTL may ask for extension of the period of validity and such a request shall be binding on Bidders. WTL's request and the response to such a request by various Bidders shall be in writing. A Bidder agreeing to such an extension will not be permitted to increase its rates.

32. TAXES & DUTIES

- The prices shall be inclusive of all taxes & levies including GST and other statutory duties as applicable. Rate of taxes should be indicated separately in the Price Bid.
- Contract Price specified in Price Bid should be based on the taxes & duties and charges prevailing at the date one day prior to the last date of Bid submission.
- Statutory deduction, wherever applicable, shall be made from invoice as per government rules. Necessary certificate will be issued for such deductions.
- Bidder submitting a bid shall produce valid statutory documents / certificates with respect to GST, Income Tax, ROC, Prof. Tax, Trade Licence, etc. All such documents / certificates shall remain valid on the last date of tender submission.
- In case of inter-state transaction, WTL will provide "Waybill". However, statutory charges, if any will be borne by the bidder.
- GST component of the invoice of the bidder may be kept on hold in case there is any mismatch / irregularity in GST return filling on the part of the bidder.

33. DISCREPANCIES IN BID

- Discrepancy between description in words and figures, the rate which corresponds to the words quoted by the bidder shall be taken as correct.
- Discrepancy in the amount quoted by the bidder due to calculation mistake of the unit rate then the unit rate shall be regarded as firm.
- Discrepancy in totaling or carry forward in the amount quoted by the bidder shall be corrected.

34. BID DUE DATE

The tender shall be submitted not later than the due date and time specified in the Important Dates Sheet. WTL may as its discretion on giving reasonable notice by fax, or any other written communication to all prospective bidders who have been issued the bid documents, extend the bid due date, in which case all rights and obligations of the WTL and the bidders, previously subject to the bid due date, shall thereafter be subject to the new bid due date as extended.

35. LATE BID

Any proposal received after the deadline for submission of proposals may not be accepted.

36. OPENING OF BID BY WTL

Bids shall be opened and downloaded in the presence of Tender Committee and Bidder's representative (maximum 2) may attend, which is not compulsory. The bidder's representatives who are present shall sign a register evidencing their attendance and produce necessary authorization. The bidder's name, Bid modifications or withdrawals, discounts and the presence or absence of relevant Bid Security and such other details as WTL office at his/her discretion, may consider appropriate, shall be announced at the opening. WTL shall open the bid security at mentioned time.

37. CONTACTING WTL

Bidder shall not approach WTL officers beyond office hours and/or outside WTL office premises from the time of the Bid opening to the time of finalization of successful bidder. Any effort by bidder to influence WTL office in the decision on Bid evaluation, Bid comparison or finalization may result in rejection of the Bidder's offer. If the bidder wishes to bring additional information to the notice of WTL, it should be in writing.

38. WTL'S RIGHT TO REJECT ANY OR ALL BIDS

WTL reserves the right to reject any bid and to annul the bidding process and reject all bids at any time prior to award of Contract, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder(s) or any obligation to inform the affected bidder(s) of the grounds for such decision.

39. BID CURRENCIES

Prices shall be quoted in Indian Rupees, inclusive of all prevailing taxes, levies, duties, cess etc.

40. PRICE

Price should be quoted in the BOQ format only. No deviation is acceptable.

- Price quoted should be firm, inclusive of packing, forwarding, insurance and freight charges.
- Percentage/specified amount of taxes & duties should be clearly mentioned otherwise WTL reserves the right to reject such vague offer.
- Price to be quoted inclusive of supply, installation & commissioning charges.

41. CANVASSING

Canvassing or support in any form for the acceptance of any tender is strictly prohibited. Any bidder doing so will render him liable to penalties, which may include removal of this name from the register of approved Contractors.

42. NON-TRANSFERABILITY OF TENDER

This tender document is not transferable.

43. FORMATS AND SIGNING OF BID

The original and all copies of the proposals shall be neatly typed and shall be signed by an authorized signatory(ies) on behalf of the Bidder. The authorization shall be provided by written Power of Attorney accompanying the proposal. All pages of the proposal, except for un-amended printed literature, shall be initialed by the person or persons signing the proposal. The proposal shall contain no interlineations, erase or overwriting. In order to correct errors made by the Bidder, all corrections shall be done & initialed with date by the authorized signatory after striking out the original words/figures completely.

44. WITHDRAWAL OF BID

Bid cannot be withdrawn during the interval between their submission and expiry of Bid's validity period. Fresh Bid may be called from eligible bidders for any additional item(s) of work not mentioned herein, if so required.

45. INTERPRETATION OF DOCUMENTS

If any bidder should find discrepancies or omission in the specifications or other tender documents, or if he should be in doubt as to the true meaning of any part thereof, he shall make a written request to the tender inviting authority for correction/clarification or interpretation or can put in a separate sheet along with his technical bid document.

46. PREPARATION OF TENDER

Tender shall be submitted in accordance with the following instructions:

- a) Tenders shall be submitted in the prescribed forms. Digital signatures shall be used. Where there is conflict between the words and the figures, the words shall govern.
- b) All notations must be in ink or type written. No erasing or overwriting will be permitted. Mistakes may be crossed out and corrections typed or written with ink adjacent thereto and must be initialed in ink by the person or persons signing the tender.
- c) Tenders shall not contain any recapitulation of the work to be done. Alternative proposals will not be considered unless called for. No written, oral, telegraphic or telephonic proposals for modifications will be acceptable.
- d) Tenders shall be uploaded as notified on or before the date and time set for the opening of tenders in the Notice Inviting Tenders.
- e) Tenders subject to any conditions or stipulations imposed by the bidder are liable to be rejected.
- f) Each and every page of the tender document must be signed with company seal by the bidder.

47. CLARIFICATION OF BIDS

During evaluation of the bids, the Customer/Tender Committee, at its discretion may ask the bidder for clarification of its bid. The request for the clarification and the response shall be in writing (fax/email) and no change in the substance of the bid shall seek offered or permitted.

48. COMPLIANCE WITH LAW

The contractor hereto agrees that it shall comply with all applicable union, state and local laws, ordinances, regulations and codes in performing its obligations hereunder, including the procurement

of licenses, permits certificates and payment of taxes where required.

The contractor shall establish and maintain all proper records (particularly, but without limitation, accounting records) required by any law, code/practice of corporate policy applicable to it from time to time including records and returns as applicable under labor legislation.

49. ERASURES OR ALTERNATIONS

The offers with overwriting and erasures may make the tender liable for rejection if each of such overwriting/erasures/manuscript ions is not only signed by the authorized signatory of the bidder. There should be no hand-written material, corrections or alterations in the offer. Technical details must be completely filled up. Correct technical information of the product being offered must be filled in. Filling up of the information using terms such as "OK", "accepted", "noted", "as given in brochure/manual" is not acceptable. The Customer may treat offers not adhering to these guidelines as unacceptable. The Customer may, at its discretion, waive any minor non-conformity or any minor irregularity in the offer. This shall be binding on all bidders and the Tender Committee reserves the right for such waivers.

50. PROCESS TO BE CONFIDENTIAL

Information relating to the examination, clarification, evaluation and comparison of Proposals, and recommendations for the award of the project shall not be disclosed to Bidders or any other persons not officially concerned with such process until the award to the successful Bidder has been announced.

51. DISQUALIFICATION

The bid is liable to be disqualified if:

- Not submitted in accordance with this RFP.
- During validity of the bid or its extended period, if any, the bidder increases his quoted prices without the consent of department to change the bid quote.
- The bidder puts his own conditions with the bid.
- Bid received in incomplete form or not accompanied by EMD.
- Awardee of the contract qualifies the letter of acceptance of the contract with his conditions.
- Bidder fails to enter into a contract within 30 working days of the date of notice of the award of tender or within such extended period, as may be specified by an authorized representative.

52. TERMINATION FOR DEFAULT

GoWB, without prejudice to any other remedy for breach of Contract or non-compliance with service levels, by written notice of default sent to the Bidder, may terminate the Contract fully or in part:

- If the selected Bidder/ fails to deliver any or all Contracted services as per service standards specified in the Contract or
- If the selected Bidder/ fails to perform any other obligation(s) under the Contract as per the contract timeline and for the period of contract, or
- If the Bidder/ selected Bidder has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices in competing for or in executing the Contract

In the event GoWB/WTL terminates the Contract in whole or in part, GoWB/WTL may procure, upon such terms and in such manner as it deems appropriate, services similar to those undelivered, and the selected Bidder shall be liable to GoWB/WTL for any excess costs for such similar services. However, the Bidder may continue performance of the Contract to the extent not terminated. GoWB/WTL would be entitled to revoke the PBG and would not be liable to pay any damages to the selected Bidder in cases comprising Termination for default.

53. TERMINATION FOR INSOLVENCY

WTL may at any time terminate the Contract by giving written notice to the selected Bidder/ if the selected Bidder/ becomes bankrupt or otherwise insolvent. In this event, termination will be without compensation to the selected Bidder, provided that such termination will not prejudice or affect any right of action or remedy which has accrued or will accrue thereafter to WTL.

54. TERMINATION FOR CONVENIENCE

WTL, by written notice sent to the vendor, may terminate the Contract, in whole or in part, at any time for its convenience. The notice of termination shall specify that termination is for its convenience. In case of termination for convenience, WBEIDC would pay to the bidder cost of services provided till the date of the termination. The PBC in such a case would be refunded to the successful bidder.

55. CONFIDENTIALITY

The Bidder shall not use or disclose to any third party, except for the purpose of the observance of these terms and Conditions any confidential information of WTL

56. PENALTY

The time schedule for the entire project and for the major activities will be agreed upon for the project between the state and the TPA. In case of any delay solely on account of TPA fault a penalty of 10% will be imposed for delay of every twelve (12) weeks' or part thereof, subject to a maximum of Thirty Six (36) weeks' delay from the scheduled target date. Beyond a delay of thirty six (36) weeks, State reserve the right to either terminate the project or ask the TPA to complete the SWAN independent audit and performance monitoring project without any extra fee.

- a. In the event of DIT/States deciding to continue the project, the penalty so computed based on the number of weeks' of actual delay will be deducted from the balance fee payable to the TPA.
- b. In the event of State deciding to terminate the project, the TPA will have to return the mobilization advance along with an interest of 9% p.a. plus the penalty so computed based on the number of weeks' of actual delay, failing which DIT/States reserves the right to invoke the bank quarantee submitted by the TPA and initiate action to recover the balance amount.

In case of delays in the project not attributable to the TPA, State may take final decision on the additional costs for the time overrun on a monthly basis (computation will be as per the quarterly payment). In case of inordinate delays beyond 12 months from the date of issue of the work order, not attributable to the TPA, the TPA would be permitted to hand over the due project deliverables at that point of time to DIT/States and withdraw from the project after receiving the fees based on completed milestones. Further, in case of inordinate delay beyond 9 months of the allotted time schedule of the Independent Audit project, if State feels that the TPA may not be able to complete the project, then State may terminate the TPA from the respective independent audit and performance monitoring project.

State shall have a right to prematurely close this Project without assigning any reason. In case of premature closure of the project by DIT/States, it shall reimburse to the TPA the fee based on the milestone percentages as per the Work Order and or milestone for which only part of the work has been completed by the TPA at the time of foreclosure, fee based on the proportion of the effort completed by the TPA, shall be paid.

57. RESOLUTION OF DISPUTES

GoWB/WTL and the selected Bidder shall make every effort to resolve amicably by direct informal negotiation any disagreement or dispute arising between them under or in connection with the Contract.

If, after thirty (30) days from the commencement of such informal negotiations, the Department and the selected Bidder have been unable to amicably resolve dispute, either party may require that the dispute be referred for resolution to the formal mechanisms, which may include, but are not restricted to, conciliation mediated by a third party acceptable to both, or in accordance with the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. In case of non agreement on the third party arbitrator, GoWB would be the sole arbitrator.

All Arbitration proceedings shall be held at West Bengal and the language of the arbitration proceedings and that of all documents and communications between the parties shall be in English.

In case the issues are not resolved in the arbitration proceedings then any further legal action by the parties shall be restricted to the jurisdiction of the Court in West Bengal.

58. GENERAL OBLIGATION OF THE BIDDER

- The Vendor shall provide all such information as may reasonably be necessary to effect
 as seamless handover as practicable in the circumstances to GoWB or its
 nominated agencies or its replacement Vendor and which the Vendor has in its
 possession or control at any time during the exit management period.
- For the purposes of this Clause, anything in the possession or control of any Vendor or associated entity is deemed to be in the possession or control of the Vendor.
- The Vendor shall commit adequate resources to comply with its obligations under this Exit Management Clause.

59. RESPONSIBILITY FOR SAFE CUSTODY AND INTEGRITY OF DATA

- The Bidder shall not, without prior written consent from GoWB/WTL, disclose the Contract, or any provision thereof, or any specification, plan, drawing, pattern, sample or information furnished by or on behalf of the department in connection therewith, to any person other than a person employed by the Bidder in the performance of the Contract. Disclosure to any such employed person shall be made in confidence and shall extend only so far, as may be necessary for purposes of such performance.
- The Bidder shall not, without prior written consent of department, make use of any
 document or information made available for the project, except for purposes of performing the
 Contract.
- All project related documents issued by department, other than the Contract itself, shall remain the property of the department and shall be returned (in all copies) to department on completion of the Bidder's performance under the Contract if so required by the department.

60. EMPLOYEES

- Promptly on reasonable request at any time during the exit management period, the Vendor shall, subject to applicable laws, restraints and regulations (including in particular those relating to privacy) provide to department or its nominated agencies a list of all employees (with job titles) of the Vendor dedicated to providing the services at the commencement of the exit management period;
- Where any national, regional law or regulation relating to the mandatory or automatic transfer of the contracts of employment from the Vendor to the department or its nominees, or a Replacement Vendor ("Transfer Regulation") applies to any or all of the employees of the Vendor, then the Parties shall comply with their respective obligations under such Transfer Regulations.
- To the extent that any Transfer Regulation does not apply to any employee of the Vendor, the department or its nominated agencies, or its Replacement Vendor may make an offer of employment or contract for services to such employee of the Vendor and the Vendor shall not enforce or impose any contractual provision that would prevent any such employee from being hired by the department or its nominated agencies or any Replacement Vendor

61. TRANSFER OF CERTAIN AGREEMENTS

On request by GoWB or its nominated agencies, the bidder shall effect such assignments, transfers, innovations, licences and sub-licenses as GoWB may require in favor of GoWB or its nominated agencies, or its Replacement Vendor in relation to any equipment lease, maintenance or service provision agreement between Vendor and third party lessors, vendors, or Vendor, and which are related to the services and reasonably necessary for the carrying out of replacement services.

62. RIGHT OF ACCESS TO PREMISES

- At any time during the exit management period, where Assets are located at the Vendor's
 premises in relations to this project, the Vendor will be obliged to give reasonable rights of
 access to (or, in the case of Assets located on a third party's premises, procure
 reasonable rights of access to) GoWB or its nominated agencies, and/or any
 Replacement Vendor in order to inventory the assets or Assets.
- The Vendor shall also give GoWB or its nominated agencies, or any Replacement Vendor right of reasonable access to the Vendor's premises and shall procure the department or its nominated agencies and any Replacement Vendor rights of access to relevant third party premises during the exit management period and for such period of time following termination or expiry of the contract as is reasonably necessary to migrate the services to GoWB or its nominated agencies, or a Replacement Vendor.

63. EXIT MANAGEMENT PLAN

- a) The Vendor shall provide to GoWB or its nominated agencies with a recommended exit management plan ("Exit Management Plan") which shall deal with at least the following aspects of exit management in relation to the contract as a whole and in relation to the Project Implementation, the Operation and Management SLA and scope of work.
 - A detailed programme of the transfer process that could be used in conjunction with a
 Replacement Vendor including details of the means to be used to ensure continuing
 provision of the services throughout the transfer process or until the cessation of the
 services and of the management structure to be used during the transfer; and
 - Plans for communication with such of the Vendor's staff, suppliers, customers and any related third party as are necessary to avoid any material detrimental impact on department's operations as a result of undertaking the transfer; and
 - If applicable, proposed arrangements for the segregation of the Vendor's networks from the networks employed by GoWB or its nominated agencies and identification of specific security tasks necessary at termination; and
 - Plans for provision of contingent support to the Department or its nominated agencies, and Replacement Vendor for a reasonable period after transfer for the purposes of providing service for replacing the Services.
- b) The Vendor shall re-draft the Exit Management Plan annually thereafter to ensure that it is kept relevant and up to date.
- c) Each Exit Management Plan shall be presented by the Vendor to and approved by GoWB or its nominated agencies.
- d) In the event of termination or expiry of the contract each Party shall comply with the Exit Management Plan.
- e) During the exit management period, the Vendor shall use its best efforts to deliver the services.
- f) Payments during the Exit Management period shall be made in accordance with the Terms of Payment Clause.
- g) This Exit Management plan shall be furnished in writing to the GoWB or its nominated agencies within 90 days from the Effective Date of the contract.

64. GENERAL TERMS

- All the pages of the bid document including documents submitted therein must be duly signed and stamped failing which the offer shall be liable to be rejected.
- b) All the documents to be submitted by the bidder along with their offer should be duly authenticated by the person signing the offer and if at any point of time during procurement process or subsequently it is detected that documents submitted are forged/tampered/manipulated in any way, the total responsibility lies with the bidder and WTL reserves the full right to take action as may be deemed fit including rejection of the offer and such case is to be kept recorded for any future dealing with them.
- c) No Technical/Commercial clarification will be entertained after opening of the tender.
- d) Overwriting and erasures may make the tender liable for rejection if each of such overwriting/erasures/manuscription is not only signed by the authorized signatory of the

- bidder. All overwriting should be separately written and signed by the authorized signatory of the bidder.
- e) No variation in or modification of the terms of the Contract shall be made except by written amendment signed by the parties.
- f) WTL reserve the right to reject or accept or withdraw the tender in full or part as the case may be without assigning the reasons thereof. No dispute of any kind can be raised the right of buyer in any court of law or elsewhere.
- g) WTL reserve the right to ask for clarification in the bid documents submitted by the bidder. Documents may be taken if decided by the committee.

A notice shall be effective from the date when delivered, tendered or affixed on notice board whichever is earlier.
- n) In case of any ambiguity in the interpretation of any of the clauses in the bid document, GoWB / WTL's interpretation of the clauses shall be final and binding on all parties.
- o) The vendor shall indemnify GoWB against all third-party claims of infringement of patent, trademark or industrial design rights arising from use of the Goods or any part thereof in reference to this project in India.
- p) The Court of Kolkata only will have the jurisdiction to deal with and decide any legal matters or dispute whatsoever arising out of the contract.

SECTION - E

TECHNO COMMERCIAL EVALUATION & AWARDING OF CONTRACT
