SCOPE OF WORK

Job title: UTM Device upgrade for integration of 5 or more ILL service providers against fail-Safe Internet for WBSWAN and proliferation of Internet / Wi-Fi Service to Horizontal offices thru' WBSWAN

Background

Internet feeds of WBSDC and WBSWAN were provided by NIC through National Knowledge Network. For reliability and greater availability of internet service, these Internet feeds were sourced from two different telecom service providers (RailTel for WBSWAN and PGCIL for WBSDC) and active-active fail-over had been implemented between these 2 service providers.

Apart from link redundancy between WBSDC and WBSWAN, NKN Internet feeds of PGCIL / RailTel are used for providing dual link redundancy to all District Head-Quarters. Every District Head Quarter (DM office) has been provided with both SWAN and NKN links. SWAN link connects directly with State Head Quarter (Moni Bhandar) and NKN link connects with NIC Regional Head Quarter at Nizam Palace. Dedicated MPLS tunnels have been created between State and District Head Quarters over NKN links, which provides automatic link redundancy between State and District Head Quarters.

Due to increasing demand for Internet / SWAN bandwidth over last few years, aggregated bandwidth usage of WBSDC and WBSWAN started crossing above 1 Gbps since early 2018, creating bottleneck and regular performance issues. To circumvent the situation both NKN feeds were upgraded from 1 to 10 Gbps in October 2019.

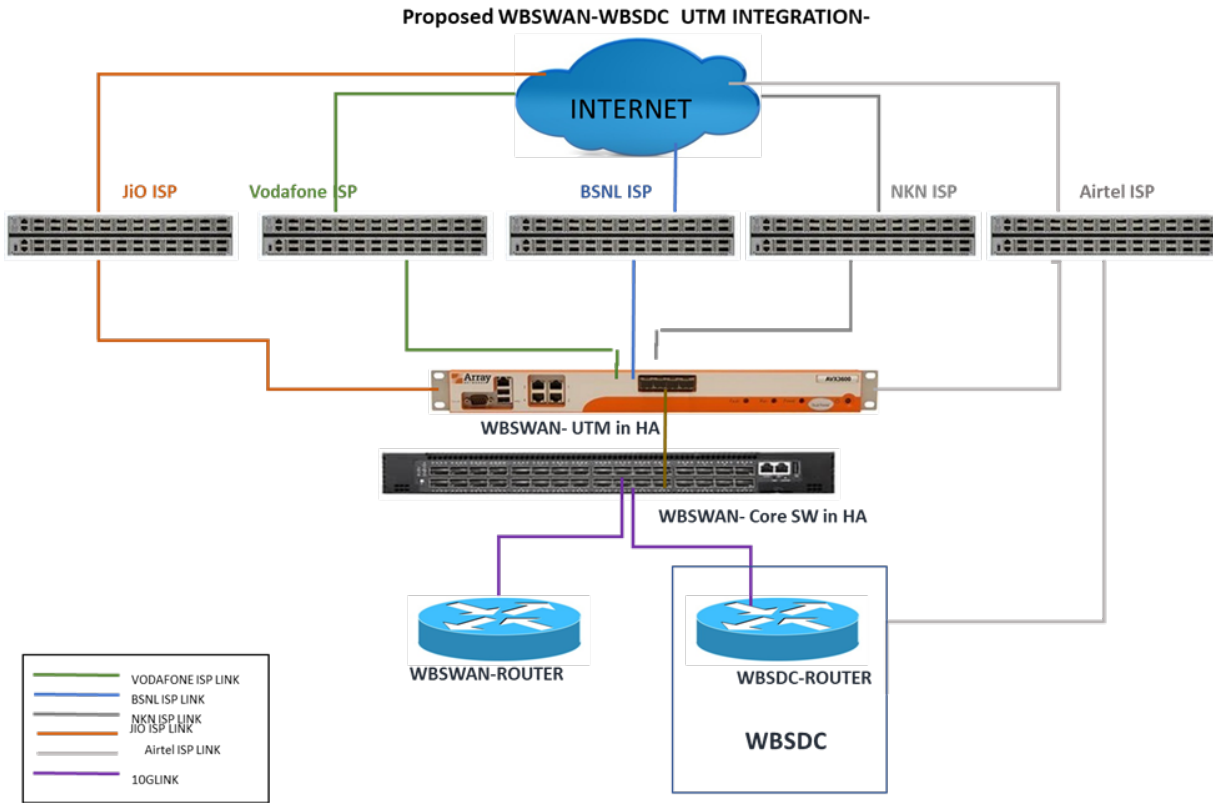
However, two service providers are not sufficient for fail-safe network architecture required for critical core infrastructure like WBSWAN and WBSDC and after Super Cyclone devastation in May 2020 across South Bengal and complete disruption of connectivity of both the service providers, other telecom service providers e.g. M/S Bharti Airtel, BSNL & Reliance Jio were roped in to provide 1 Gbps internet feed each at the WBSWAN HQ / WBSDC at Monibhandar.

Considering the growing criticality of e-Governance infrastructure like WBSDC and WBSWAN State Head Quarter, now all major telecom service providers (M/s PGCIL, RailTel, Bharti Airtel, BSNL and Reliance Jio) have provided ILL service to WBSWAN and WBSDC through one common integrated Internet Exchange Gateway installed at WBSWAN end and provide necessary internet bandwidth to WBSDC as per bandwidth demand and redundancy requirement of WBSDC. The additional internet bandwidth accumulated at WBSWAN end due to addition of above mentioned ILL feeds will be redistributed to various departments and directorates through WBSWAN. In the event of any catastrophic link failure across multiple service providers and internet blackout at WBSDC, these ILL services integrated at WBSWAN will be activated for restoration of WBSDC.

To integrate 5 or more ILL feeds the present UTM deployed in WBSWAN (Sonicwall Model 2650) is not sufficient and needs to be upgraded. Hence an UTM (in HA mode) to handle minimum 5 nos of ISPs with the enhanced capacity as mentioned in the Technical Specification is to be provided under the present scope of work.

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The proposed architecture is attached below:



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SECTION – B

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

1. The bidder must be a company registered under Companies Act, 1956/2013 or Partnership or LLP or OPC or Proprietary Firm. Documentary evidence to be submitted.
2. The bidder should have their presence in Kolkata with own office. Valid proof should be submitted along with the bid.
3. The bidder should have valid GST Registration Certificate & PAN. Bidder shall have to submit photocopy of the documents.
4. The bidder shall have executed “Similar Nature” of single order an amount not less than Rs.10.00 lakh in last three financial years and current financial year (considering FY - 2017-18, 2018-19, 2019-20) in Government Department/PSU/Autonomous Body any reputed organization. References order copy for the project to be provided.
5. Bidder should have local call center number. Call Center details with number & detailed escalation matrix to be submitted.
6. The bidder should have an average annual turnover of not less than Rs. 2.00 Crore per year in the last three financial years (FY – 2017-18, 2018-19, 2019-20). Bidder shall have to submit Audited Balance Sheet / Audited Accounts / Auditor Certificate in support of their claim.
7. Bidder should transfer Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) of Rs. 80,000.00 (Rupees Eighty thousand only) electronically to Webel Technology Limited as per the details given in Clause – 9, Section - D.
8. Bidder should transfer Tender Fee of Rs. 4,000.00 (Rupees Four thousand only) electronically to Webel Technology Limited as per the details given in Clause – 9, Section - D.
9. Manufacturer’s tender specific authorizations for the items (UTM Device) must be submitted as per format enclosed (Section - P).
10. The bidder shall have Quality Certificate (ISO 9001:2015). Copy of valid Certificate to be submitted.
11. The Bidder must have Support Service Center with manpower in Kolkata so that any call reported is attended and resolved promptly within stipulated response time mentioned in this tender. The detailed Support Service with manpower for bidder should be submitted as per format (Section –N).
12. The bidder shall submit Bid Form (Section – F) duly signed by the authorized signatory of the company as per the format enclosed. Deviation in format may not be accepted.
13. The bidder shall not have been blacklisted by any State/Central Government or PSU Organization or bilateral/multilateral funding agencies for breach of ethical conduct or fraudulent practices as on date of submission of the proposal. Declaration on bidder’s letter head to be submitted.

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SECTION – D

INSTRUCTION TO BIDDER

1. DEFINITIONS

In this document, the following terms shall have following respective meanings:

“Acceptance Test Document” means a document, which defines procedures for testing the functioning of installed system. The document will be finalized with the contractor within 7 days of issuance of the Letter of Award/Confirm Work Order.

“Agreement” means the Agreement to be signed between the successful bidder and WTL including all attachments, appendices, all documents incorporated by reference thereto together with any subsequent modifications, the RFP, the bid offer, the acceptance and all related correspondences, clarifications, presentations.

“Bidder” means any firm offering the solution(s), service(s) and /or materials required in the RFP. The word Bidder when used in the pre award period shall be synonymous with Bidder, and when used after award of the Contract shall mean the successful Bidder with whom WTL signs the agreement for supply, install, commission and render services for the systems.

“Contract” is used synonymously with Agreement.

“Contract Price” means the price to be paid to the Contractor for providing the Solution, in accordance with the payment terms.

“Contractor” means the Bidder whose bid to perform the Contract has been accepted by Tender Committee and is named as such in the Letter of Award.

“Default Notice” shall mean the written notice of Default of the Agreement issued by one Party to the other.

“Installation” shall mean UTM Device upgrade for integration of 5 or more ILL service providers against fail-Safe Internet for WBSWAN and proliferation of Internet / Wi-Fi Service to Horizontal offices thru' WBSWAN under Department of Information Technology & Electronics, GoWB

“Fraudulent Practice” means a misrepresentation of facts in order to influence a procurement process or the execution of a Contract and includes collusive practice among Bidders (prior to or after Bid submission) designed to establish Bid prices at artificial noncompetitive levels and to deprive the benefits of free and open competition.

“Good Industry Practice” shall mean the exercise of that degree of skill, diligence and prudence which would reasonably and ordinarily be expected from a reasonably skilled and experienced Operator engaged in the same type of undertaking under the same or similar circumstances.

“Government” / “Gov. of W. Bengal” means the Government of West Bengal.

“GoI” shall stand for the Government of India.

“GoWB” means Government of West Bengal

“WTL” means Webel Technology Limited a Gov. of W. Bengal undertaking.

“IT” means Department of Information Technology & Electronics, GoWB

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“Personnel” means persons hired by the Bidder as employees and assigned to the performance of the Infrastructure Solution or any part thereof.

“Project” means UTM Device upgrade for integration of 5 or more ILL service providers against fail-Safe Internet for WBSWAN and proliferation of Internet / Wi-Fi Service to Horizontal offices thru’ WBSWAN under Department of Information Technology & Electronics, GoWB.

“Project Plan” means the document to be developed by the Contractor and approved by WTL, based on the requirements of the Contract and the Preliminary Project Plan included in the Contractor’s bid. For the sake of clarity, the Agreed and Finalized Project Plan” refers to the version of the Project Plan submitted by the contractor after receiving the letter of Award and the same approved by WTL. The project plan may be changed/ modified during the course of the project. Should the Project Plan conflict with the provisions of the Contract in any way, the relevant provisions of the Contract, including any amendments, shall prevail.

“Services” means the work to be performed by the Bidder pursuant to this Contract, as described in the detailed Scope of Work.

“Similar Nature” includes Setting of UTM Device.

“Interest rate” means “364 days Government of India (GoI) Treasury Bills” rate.

“Law” shall mean any Act, notification, bye law, rules and regulations, directive, ordinance, order or instruction having the force of law enacted or issued by the Central Government and/or the Government of West Bengal or any other Government or regulatory authority or political subdivision of government agency.

“LOI” means issuing of Letter of Intent shall constitute the intention of the WTL to place the Purchase Order with the successful bidder.

“Operator” means the company providing the services under Agreement.

“Requirements” shall mean and include schedules, details, description, statement of technical data, performance characteristics, standards (Indian as well as International) as applicable and specified in the Contract.

“Service” means provision of Contracted service viz., operation, maintenance and associated services for DEPLOYED SYSTEMS as per Section titled “Scope of Work”

“Termination Notice” means the written notice of termination of the Agreement issued by WTL.

“Uptime” means the time period when specified services are available with specified technical and service standards as mentioned in section titled WARRANTY SUPPORT” **“%Uptime”** means ratio of 'up time' (in minutes) as mentioned in section titled “Warranty support”

“Service Down Time” (SDT) means the time period when specified services with specified technical and operational requirements as mentioned in section titled “WARRANTY SUPPORT” are not available to Gov. of W. Bengal and its user departments and organizations.

2. PRE BID MEETING

Pre Bid Meeting will be held on 10.03.2021 at 11.30 hrs. at premises of WTL. Bidder can send their queries as per format (Section - M) to Manager (Purchase) (purchase@wtl.co.in). Only the queries received within the stipulated date prior to the Pre Bid Meeting will be answered. The entrance to the Pre Bid Meeting will be limited to one person per bidder and carrying valid authorization letter on official letter head bearing company seal.

3. COST OF BIDDING

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The bidder shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of the bid and WTL will in no case be responsible for those costs regardless of the conduct or outcome of the bidding process.

4. BID DOCUMENT

Bidder is expected to examine all instructions, forms, terms and requirements in the bid document. The invitation to bid together with all its attachments thereto shall be considered to be read, understood and accepted by the bidder unless deviations are specifically stated in the serials by the bidder. Failure to furnish all information required by the bid document or a bid not substantially responsive to the bid document in every respect may result in the rejection of the bid.

5. AMENDMENT OF BID DOCUMENT

At any time prior to the deadline for submission of proposals, WTL reserves the right to add/modify/delete any portion of this document by issuance of a Corrigendum, which would be published on the website and will also be made available to all the Bidders who have been issued the tender document. The Corrigendum shall be binding on all bidders and will form part of the bid documents.

6. MODIFICATION AND WITHDRAWAL OF BIDS

The bidder cannot modify or withdraw its bid after submission.

7. LANGUAGE OF BID & CORRESPONDENCE

The proposal will be prepared by the Bidder in English language only. All the documents relating to the proposal (including brochures) supplied by the firm should also be in English, and the correspondence between the Bidder & WTL will be in English language only. The correspondence by fax/E-mail must be subsequently confirmed by a duly signed formal copy.

8. BIDDER'S SOLUTION

The bidders are requested to study the Bill of Material supplied with this document carefully. While working out the solution the bidder has to work with the broad minimum specification provided in the tender documents, conforming to the model, make and Part number (wherever provided). While submitting the bid the bidder has to detail out all components needed to complete the system BOM. The bidder is required to quote for each item retaining all major components/sub system detailed and specified. As the contractor will be responsible for smooth functioning of the system, availability of spares during the tenure of the warranty period has to be taken care of by the contractor to maintain the guaranteed uptime.

9. EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT (EMD)

The bidder shall furnish Tender Fee of Rs. 4000.00 (Rupees Four thousand only) and EMD of Rs. 80000/- (Rupees Eighty Thousand only) by transferring the amount electronically to the undernoted Bank Account.

The bidder has to intimate the details of Remittance such as Tender No. / Tender Date / Tender Fee Amount / EMD Amount / UTR No. of Transaction(s) / Transaction Date, etc. through email to Mr. Rupak Roy – (rupak.roy@wtl.co.in) and copy to Mr. Arunava Saha – (purchase@wtl.co.in). prior to the opening of the bid.

The bidder shall also furnish the details of Tender Fee & EMD submission in the bid document. In absence of payment details prior to Bid Opening, then the bid will be considered as invalid bid. Any bid not accompanied with the EMD & Tender Fee shall be rejected.

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The bidders are also requested to furnish the Bank Account details (Name of the Bank, Account Number, IFS Code, etc) for refund of EMD in case of unsuccessful bidder.

10. FORFEITURE OF EMD

EMD made by Bidder may be forfeited under the following conditions:

If Bidder withdraws the proposal before the expiry of validity period.

During the evaluation process, if a Bidder indulges in any such activity as would jeopardize the process, the decision of WTL regarding forfeiture of EMD shall be final and shall not be called upon question under any circumstances.

If Bidder violates any of the provisions of the terms and conditions of the proposal.

In the case of a successful Bidder, if Bidder fails to:

- a) Accept the work order along with the terms and conditions.
- b) Furnish performance security.
- c) Violates any of the work conditions of this proposal or indulges in any such activities as would jeopardize the work.
- d) Submitting false/misleading information/declaration/documents/proof/etc.

The decision of WTL regarding forfeiture of EMD shall be final and shall not be called upon to question under any circumstances, besides, forfeiture of EMD even the Bidder will be deferred from participating in any job for a period of one year.

11. FORMS AND FORMATS

The various inputs for the Techno Commercial as Financial Bids are to be submitted in the format specified. The bidder shall use the form, wherever specified, to provide relevant information. If form does not provide space for any required information, space at the end of the form or additional sheets shall be used to convey the said information. For all other cases, the bidder shall design a form to hold the required information.

12. LACK OF INFORMATION TO BIDDER

The bidder shall be deemed to have carefully examined the Bid document to his entire satisfaction. Any lack of information shall not relieve the bidder of his responsibility to fulfill his obligation under the bid. If bidder has any queries relating to bid document then he can send the queries before the Pre Bid Meeting.

13. CONTRACT EXECUTION

On receipt of the Letter of Award the contractor should submit a Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG) equivalent to 10% of the total contract value within three weeks from the date of receipt of Letter of Award/Order. The PBG should be valid for six months more than the warranty period. All delivery of the material will have to be completed within 45 days from the date of acceptance of contract and the contractor has to ensure all activities leading to the commissioning of the contract to be completed within 90 days from the date of award. Subsequent to the award of contract, the contractor will have to arrange for the requisite material as per BOM.

14. TIME SCHEDULE FOR DELIVERY & INSTALLATION

The total job to be completed within 4 (Four) weeks from the date of Order.

13. LIQUIDATED DAMAGE / PENALTY

The job includes the supply and installation of materials mentioned in the tender document. In the event of failure to meet the job completion in stipulated date/time liquidated damage may be imposed on the contractor for sum not less than 0.5% of the contract value for that item/job for each week or part thereof, subject to a ceiling of 10% of the total contract value (excluding all taxes & duties and other charges). In the event of LD exceeds 10% of the order value, WTL reserves the right to terminate the

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contract and WTL will get the job completed by any other competent party. The difference of cost incurred by WTL will be recovered from the contractor and PBG will be invoked.

15. LIABILITY

In case of a default on bidder's part or other liability, WTL shall be entitled to recover damages from the Contractor. In each such instance, regardless of the basis on which WTL is entitled to claim damages from the Contractor (including fundamental breach, negligence, misrepresentation, or other contract or tort claim), Contractor shall be liable for no more than:

- Payment referred to in the Patents and Copyrights clause.
- Liability for bodily injury (including death) or damage to real property and tangible personal property limited to that cause by the Contractor's negligence.
- As to any other actual damage arising in any situation involving nonperformance by Contractor pursuant to or in any way related to the subject of this Agreement, the charge paid by WTL for the individual product or Service that is the subject of the Claim. However, the contractor shall not be liable for
- For any indirect, consequential loss or damage, lost profits, third party loss or damage to property or loss of or damage to data.

For any direct loss or damage that exceeds the total payment for Contract Price made or expected to be made to the Contractor hereunder.

16. PATENTS & COPYRIGHT

If a third party claims that a product delivered by the Contractor to WTL infringes that party's patent or copyright, the Contractor shall defend WTL against that claim at Contractor's expense and pay all costs, damages, and attorney's fees that a court finally awards or that are included in a settlement approved by the Contractor, provided that WTL.

- Promptly notifies Contractor in writing of the claim
- Allows Contractor to control and co-operate with Contractor in the defense and any related settlement negotiations.

Remedies: If such a claim is made or appears likely to be made, WTL would permit Contractor to enable WTL to continue to use the product, or to modify it, or replace it with one that is at least functionally equivalent. If Contractor determines that none of these alternatives is reasonably available, WTL agrees to return the product to Contractor on Contractor's written request. Contractor will then give WTL a credit equal to for a machine. WTL's net book value (provided WTL has followed generally accepted accounting principles for a generally available software product produced by Contractor (Program) the amount paid by WTL or 12 months charges (whichever is lesser) and for materials the amount paid by WTL for the materials. These will be Contractor's entire obligation regarding any claim of infringement.

17. SUSPENSION OF WORK

WTL shall have the power at any time and from time to time by notice to the Contractor to delay or suspend the progress of the work or any part of the work due to any other adequate reasons and on receipt of such notice the contractor shall forthwith suspend further progress of the work until further notice from WTL. The Contractor shall recommence work immediately after receiving a notice to do so from WTL. The whole or any part of the time lost for such delay or suspension shall, if WTL in its absolute discretion thinks fit, but not otherwise, be added to the time allowed for completion.

18. TERMS OF PAYMENT

Payment terms will be on back-to-back basis, i.e., payment will be made only on receipt of payment from relevant customer i.e., Department of Information Technology & Electronics, GoWB.

19. GOVERNING LAWS

This contract should be governed by and interpreted by Arbitration clause in accordance with Laws in force in India. The courts at Kolkata shall have exclusive jurisdiction in all matters arising under the contract. The selected vendor shall keep himself fully informed of all current national, state and municipal law and ordinances. The selected vendor shall at their own expense, obtain all necessary permits and license and pay all fees and taxes required by law. These will be selected vendor's entire obligation regarding any claim of infringement. The selected vendor hereto agrees that it shall comply

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with all applicable union, state and local laws, ordinances, regulations and codes in performing its obligations hereunder, including the procurement of licenses, permits certificates and payment of taxes where required. The selected vendor shall establish and maintain all proper records (particularly, but without limitation, accounting records) required by any law, code/practice of corporate policy applicable to it from time to time including records and returns as applicable under labor legislation.

20. CORRUPT OR FRAUDULENT PRATICES

The Tender Committee requires that the bidders under this Tender observe the highest standards of ethics during the procurement and execution of such contracts. For this purpose, the definition of corrupt and fraudulent practices will follow the provisions of the relevant laws in force. The Tender Committee will reject a proposal for award if it detects that the bidder has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices in competing for the contract in question. The Tender Committee will declare a firm ineligible, either indefinitely or for a stated period of time, if it at any time determines that the firm has engaged in corrupt and fraudulent practices in competing for, or in executing, a contract.

21. BINDING CLAUSE

All decisions taken by the Tender Committee regarding the processing of this tender and award of contract shall be final and binding on all parties concerned. The Tender Committee reserves the right:

- To vary, modify, revise, amend or change any of the terms and conditions mentioned above and,
- To reject any or all the Tender/s without assigning any reason whatsoever thereof or to annul the bidding process and reject all bids at any time prior to award of contract, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder(s) or any obligation to inform the affected bidder(s) of the grounds for such decision.

22. WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION

In every case in which by virtue of the provision of the workmen's compensation Act 1923 or any other relevant acts and rules, compensation to a workman employed by the contractor, is payable, then this should be done by the Contractor. If WTL is obliged to make any compensation under the said rules and acts, then the amount shall be recovered without prejudice, from the bills and due of the Contractor. WTL shall not be bound to contest any claim made against the Contractor in respect of workmen's compensation.

23. CONTRACTOR'S EMPLOYEES

The Contractor shall comply with the provision of all labour legislation including the requirement of the payment of Wage Act 1936 and the rules framed there under and modifications thereof in respect of men employed by him in carrying out the contract. The Contractor must ensure that he complies with PF, ESI regulation for all his deployed employees. The Contractor shall see that all authorized Sub Contractors under him similarly complied with the above requirement.

24. SAFETY MEASURES

The Contractor shall in the course of execution of the work take all necessary precaution for the protection of all persons and property. The Contractor shall take adequate measures to protect the work and prevent accident during the work. In the event of any accident to any person or persons or damage or injury of any description to any person or property due to failure on the part of the contractor in taking proper precautionary measures the contractor shall be responsible for and must make good the loss the damage at his own cost to the satisfaction of the department and employees of the department shall be indemnified from all claims or liabilities arising there from or any expenses incurred on account thereof.

25. EQUIPMENT

All tools & tackles necessary for the work shall have to be procured by the contractor unless otherwise specified elsewhere in these tender documents. The equipment used by the contractor for a particular work must be appropriate for the type of work. The contractor shall maintain the equipment used on the work properly so that they are in good working condition. In no case shall the contractor use defective or imperfect equipment in the work. The contractor shall arrange to replace or repair all defective equipment so that the progress of the work is not hampered. No defective equipment should be left at

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the site of work and the department shall not be responsible for any loss or damage to any of these equipments during the course of the execution of the work.

26. SUB-CONTRACT

The purchaser (WTL) does not recognize the existence of Sub-Contractors. The Contractor's responsibility is not transferable. No consortium partner is allowed.

27. TERMINATION FOR DEFAULT

WTL may without prejudice to any other remedy or right of claim for breach of contract by giving not less than 30 days written notice of default sent to the contractor, terminate the order in whole or in part. If the contractor materially fails to render any or all the services within the time period specified in the contract or any extension thereof granted by WTL in writing and fails to remedy its failure within a period of thirty days after receipt of default notice from WTL. If the project (delivery, commissioning as well as warranty maintenance support is not carried out according to specification due to deficiency in service as per terms of the contract. In such case WTL will invoke the amount held back from the contractor as PBG.

28. BANKRUPTCY

If the contractor becomes bankrupt or have a receiving order made against him or compound with his creditors or being a corporation commence to be wound up, not being a voluntary winding up for the purpose only or amalgamation or reconstruction, or carry on their business under a receiver for the benefit of their creditors or any of them, WTL shall be at liberty to terminate the engagement forthwith without any notice in writing to the contractor or to the liquidator or receiver or to any person in whom the contractor may become vested and without any compensation to give such liquidator or receiver or other person the option of carrying out the engagement subject to their providing a guarantee for the due and faithful performance of the engagement up to an amount to be determined by WTL.

29. FORCE MAJEURE

It is hereby defined as any cause, which is beyond the control of the Contractor or WTL as the case may be, which such party could not foresee or with a reasonable amount of diligence could not have foreseen and which substantially affect the performance of the contract, such as

- War, Hostilities or warlike operations (whether a state of war be declared or not), invasion, act of foreign enemy and civil war.
- Rebellion, revolution, insurrection, mutiny, usurpation of civil or military, government, conspiracy, riot, civil commotion and terrorist area.
- Confiscation, nationalization, mobilization, commandeering or requisition by or under the order of any government or de facto authority or ruler, or any other act or failure to act of any local state or national government authority.
- Strike, sabotage, lockout, embargo, import restriction, port congestion, lack of usual means of public transportation and communication, industrial dispute, shipwreck, shortage of power supply epidemics, quarantine and plague.
- Earthquake, landslide, volcanic activity, fire flood or inundation, tidal wave, typhoon or cyclone, hurricane, nuclear and pressure waves or other natural or physical disaster.

If either party is prevented, hindered or delayed from or in performing any of its obligations under the Contract by an event of Force Majeure, then it shall notify the other in writing of the occurrence of such event and the circumstances of the event of Force Majeure within fourteen days after the occurrence of such event. The party who has given such notice shall be excused from the performance or punctual performance of its obligations under the Contract for so long as the relevant event of Force Majeure continues and to the extent that such party's performance is prevented, hindered or delayed.

The party or parties affected by the event of Force Majeure shall use reasonable efforts to mitigate the effect of the event of Force Majeure upto its or their performance of the Contract and to fulfill its or their obligation under the Contract but without prejudice to either party's right to terminate the Contract.

No delay or nonperformance by either party to this Contract caused by the occurrence of any event of Force Majeure shall.

- Constitute a default or breach of the contract.

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- Give rise to any claim for damages or additional cost or expense occurred by the delay or nonperformance. If, and to the extent, that such delay or nonperformance is caused by the occurrence of an event of Force Majeure.

30. INSURANCE COVERAGE

Appropriate insurance to cover all solution components for the transit period and until the time of its acceptance at the respective site is to be taken by the contractor. As the contractor will carry the risk for the material in his books during transit, the contractor should arrange insurance for the total system as period from the dispatch till Acceptance Test is successfully achieved. Further the contractor is to take all required insurance coverage in respect of all its personnel who shall be working on this engagement.

31. WARRANTY

The OEM on behalf of bidder will warranty that products supplied under the contract are newly made and are free from defects in the design, engineering and workmanship. The bidder would be responsible for the up keep and maintenance support under the scope of work during the entire warranty period, i.e., 36 months for the total work from the date of final acceptance of the system by the user. Within warranty period, entrusted OEM will replace, re-integrate faulty, buggy components. The bidder shall not, without the express prior written consent of WTL, assign to any third party of the contract or part thereof. Service support for the entire warranty period will be on site and comprehensive (including spares) and free of cost for the entire warranty period. Warranty will be invalid if the equipment is serviced by unauthorized personnel of misuse is detected.

32. WARRANTY SUPPORT

The total system will be warranted against bad workmanship and manufacturing defects for 36 months from the date of acceptance of the system whole or part. Service support for the entire warranty period will be on site and comprehensive (including spares and all other support) and free of cost for the entire warranty period. The bidder should have a call centre in Kolkata. The contact details of the call centre must be furnished along with the bid. Any call logged with the service centre must be given a running docket number to the person reporting the call. Maximum response time – Next Business day. Call resolution time – 48 hrs maximum. If the uptime goes below the prescribed limit in any quarter, the same will be noted. At the scheduled end of the warranty period the total of such deviation will be done and the contractor will have to extend the warranty support by the default time. Penalty shall be deducted for deviation of warranty support. Proposed Solution should have Hardware redundancy from day one.

33. PERFORMANCE BANK GUARANTEE (PBG)

As a guarantee for timely delivery, installation and commissioning of equipment as well as performance of on-site warranty support, as mentioned in Bill of Material, from the date of final acceptance of systems and pertaining to proper running of the systems, the bidder will have to submit 10% of the contract value as security in the form of Performance Bank Guarantee from any nationalized bank as per format enclosed (Section – Q).

34. SI/BIDDER/CONTRACTOR'S RESPONSIBILITIES

Refer Section - A

35. NO WAIVER OF RIGHTS

Neither the inspection by WTL or any of their agents nor any order by WTL for payment of money or any payment for or acceptance of the whole or any part of the works by WTL, nor any extension of time, nor any possession taken by WTL shall operate as a waiver of any provision of the contract or of any power reserved to WTL, or any right to damages here in provided, nor shall any waiver of any breach in the contract be held to be a waiver of any other subsequent breach.

36. ENFORCEMENT OF TERMS

The failure of either party to enforce at any time any of the provision of this contract or any rights in respect thereto or to exercise any option here in provided shall in no way be construed to be a waiver to such provisions, rights or options or in any way to affect the validity of the contract. The exercise by

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either party of any of its rights herein shall not preclude or prejudice either party from exercising the same or any other right it may have hereunder.

37. PERIOD OF VALIDITY OF OFFER

For the purpose of placing the order, the proposals shall remain valid till 180 days. During the period of validity of proposals, the rates quoted shall not change. In exceptional circumstances, WTL may ask for extension of the period of validity and such a request shall be binding on Bidders. WTL's request and the response to such a request by various Bidders shall be in writing. A Bidder agreeing to such an extension will not be permitted to increase its rates.

38. TAXES & DUTIES

- The prices shall be inclusive of all taxes & levies including GST and other statutory duties as applicable. Rate of taxes should be indicated separately in the Price Bid.
- Contract Price specified in Price Bid should be based on the taxes & duties and charges prevailing at the date one day prior to the last date of Bid submission.
- Statutory deduction, wherever applicable, shall be made from invoice as per government rules. Necessary certificate will be issued for such deductions.

43. CONTACTING WTL

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44. WTL'S RIGHT TO REJECT ANY OR ALL BIDS

WTL reserves the right to reject any bid and to annul the bidding process and reject all bids at any time prior to award of Contract, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder(s) or any obligation to inform the affected bidder(s) of the grounds for such decision.

45. BID CURRENCIES

Prices shall be quoted in Indian Rupees, inclusive of all prevailing taxes, levies, duties, cess etc.

46. PRICE

- Price should be quoted in the BOQ format only. No deviation is acceptable.
- Price quoted should be firm, inclusive of packing, forwarding, insurance and freight charges.
- Percentage/specified amount of taxes & duties should be clearly mentioned otherwise WTL reserves the right to reject such vague offer.
- Price to be quoted inclusive of supply, installation & commissioning charges.

47. CANVASSING

Canvassing or support in any form for the acceptance of any tender is strictly prohibited. Any bidder doing so will render him liable to penalties, which may include removal of this name from the register of approved Contractors.

48. NON-TRANSFERABILITY OF TENDER

This tender document is not transferable.

49. FORMATS AND SIGNING OF BID

The original and all copies of the proposals shall be neatly typed and shall be signed by an authorized signatory(ies) on behalf of the Bidder. The authorization shall be provided by written Power of Attorney accompanying the proposal. All pages of the proposal, except for un-amended printed literature, shall be initialed by the person or persons signing the proposal. The proposal shall contain no interlineations, erase or overwriting. In order to correct errors made by the Bidder, all corrections shall be done & initialed with date by the authorized signatory after striking out the original words/figures completely.

50. WITHDRAWAL OF BID

Bid cannot be withdrawn during the interval between their submission and expiry of Bid's validity period. Fresh Bid may be called from eligible bidders for any additional item(s) of work not mentioned herein, if so required.

51. INTERPRETATION OF DOCUMENTS

If any bidder should find discrepancies or omission in the specifications or other tender documents, or if he should be in doubt as to the true meaning of any part thereof, he shall make a written request to the tender inviting authority for correction/clarification or interpretation or can put in a separate sheet along with his technical bid document.
