"Default Notice" shall mean the written notice of Default of the Agreement issued by one Party to the other.

15. LIQUIDATED DAMAGE / PENALTY

The job includes the supply and installation of materials mentioned in the tender document. 17. PATENTS & COPYRIGHT

If a third party claims that a product delivered by the Contractor to WTL infringes that party's patent or copyright, the Contractor shall defend WTL against that claim at Contractor's expense and pay all costs, damages, and attorney's fees that a court finally awards or that are included in a settlement approved by the Contractor, provided that WTL.

WTL shall have the power at any time and from time to time by notice to the Contractor to delay or suspend the progress of the work or any part of the work due to any other adequate reasons and on receipt of such notice the contractor shall forthwith suspend further progress of the work until further notice from WTL. The Contractor shall recommence work immediately after receiving a notice to do so from WTL. The whole or any part of the time lost for such delay or suspension shall, if WTL in its absolute discretion thinks fit, but not otherwise, be added to the time allowed for completion.

19. TERMS OF PAYMENT

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Payment terms will be on back-to-back basis, i.e., payment will be made only on receipt of payment from relevant customer, i.e. Directorate of Commercial Taxes, GoWB. A scheduled payment terms depicted below: Delivery will phase wise and payment will be release phase wise as per following mode.

a) Half Yearly deferred payment will be made after successful installation & integration of Links.

20. GOVERNING LAWS

This contract should be governed by and interpreted by Arbitration clause in accordance with Laws in force in India. The courts at Kolkata shall have exclusive jurisdiction in all matters arising under the contract. The selected vendor shall keep himself fully informed of all current national, state and municipal law and ordinances. The selected vendor shall at their own expense, obtain all necessary permits and license and pay all fees and taxes required by law. These will be selected vendor's entire obligation regarding any claim of infringement. The selected vendor hereto agrees that it shall comply with all applicable union, state and local laws, ordinances, regulations and codes in performing its obligations hereunder, including the procurement of licenses, permits certificates and payment of taxes where required. The selected vendor shall establish and maintain all proper records (particularly, but without limitation, accounting records) required by any law, code/practice of corporate policy applicable to it from time to time including records and returns as applicable under labor legislation.

21. CORRUPT OR FRAUDULENT

The Tender Committee requires that the bidders under this Tender observe the highest standards of ethics during the procurement and execution of such contracts. For this purpose the definition of corrupt and fraudulent practices will follow the provisions of the relevant laws in force. The Tender Committee will reject a proposal for award if it detects that the bidder has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices in competing for the contract in question. The Tender Committee will declare a firm ineligible, either indefinitely or for a stated period of time, if it at any time determines that the firm has engaged in corrupt and fraudulent practices in competing for, or in executing, a contract.

22. BIDING CLAUSE

All decisions taken by the Tender Committee regarding the processing of this tender and award of contract shall be final and binding on all parties concerned.

The Tender Committee reserves the right:

- To vary, modify, revise, amend or change any of the terms and conditions mentioned above and,
- To reject any or all the Tender/s without assigning any reason whatsoever thereof or to annul the bidding process and reject all bids at any time prior to award of contract, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder(s) or any obligation to inform the affected bidder(s) of the grounds for such decision.

23. WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION

In every case in which by virtue of the provision of the workmen's compensation Act 1923 or any other relevant acts and rules, compensation to a workmen employed by the contractor, is payable, then this should be done by the Contractor. If WTL is obliged to make any compensation under the said rules and acts, then the amount shall be recovered without prejudice, from the bills and due of the Contractor. WTL shall not be bound to contest any claim made against the Contractor in respect of workmen's compensation.

24. CONTRACTOR'S EMPLOYEES

The Contractor shall comply with the provision of all labour legislation including the requirement of the payment of Wage Act 1936 and the rules framed there under and modifications thereof in respect of men employed by him in carrying out the contract. The Contractor must ensure that he complies with PF, ESI regulation for all his deployed employees. The Contractor shall see that all authorized Sub Contractors under him similarly complied with the above requirement.

25. SAFETY MEASURES

The Contractor shall in the course of execution of the work take all necessary precaution for the protection of all persons and property. The Contractor shall take adequate measures to protect the work and present accident during the work. In the event of any accident to any person or persons or damage or injury of any description to any person or property due to failure on the part of the contractor in taking proper precautionary measures the contractor shall be responsible for and must make good the loss the damage at his own cost to the satisfaction of the department and employees of the department shall be indemnified from all claims or liabilities arising there from or any expenses incurred on account thereof.

26. EQUIPMENT

All tools & tackles necessary for the work shall have to be procured by the contractor unless other wise specified elsewhere in these tender documents. The equipment used by the contractor for a particular work must be

appropriate for the type of work. The contractor shall maintain the equipment used on the work properly so that they are in good working condition. In no case shall the contractor use defective or imperfect equipment in the work. The contractor shall arrange to replace or repair all defective equipment so that the progress of the work is not hampered. No defective equipment should be left at the site of work and the department shall not be responsible for any loss or damage to any of these equipments during the course of the execution of the work.

27. SUB-CONTRACT

The purchaser (WTL) does not recognize the existence of Sub-Contractors. The Contractor's responsibility is not transferable. No consortium partner is allowed.

28. TERMINATION FOR DEFAULT

WTL may without prejudice to any other remedy or right of claim for breach of contract by giving not less than 30 days written notice of default sent to the contractor, terminate the order in whole or in part. If the contractor materially fails to render any or all the services within the time period specified in the contract or any extension thereof granted by WTL in writing and fails to remedy its failure within a period of thirty days after receipt of default notice from WTL. If the project (delivery, commissioning as well as warranty maintenance support is not carried out according to specification due to deficiency in service as per terms of the contract. In such case WTL will invoke the amount held back from the contractor as PBG.

29. BANKRUPTCY

If the contractor becomes bankrupt or have a receiving order made against him or compound with his creditors or being a corporation commence to be wound up, not being a voluntary winding up for the purpose only or amalgamation or reconstruction, or carry on their business under a receiver for the benefit of their creditors or any of them, WTL shall be at liberty to terminate the engagement forthwith without any notice in writing to the contractor or to the liquidator or receiver or to any person in whom the contractor may become vested and without any compensation to give such liquidator or receiver or other person the option of carrying out the engagement subject to their providing a guarantee for the due and faithful performance of the engagement up to an amount to be determined by WTL.

30. FORCE MAJEURE

It is hereby defined as any cause, which is beyond the control of the Contractor or WTL as the case may be, which such party could not foresee or with a reasonable amount of diligence could not have foreseen and which substantially affect the performance of the contract, such as

- War, Hostilities or warlike operations (whether a state of war be declared or not), invasion, act of foreign enemy and civil war.
- Rebellion, revolution, insurrection, mutiny, usurpation of civil or military, government, conspiracy, riot, civil commotion and terrorist area.
- Confiscation, nationalization, mobilization, commandeering or requisition by or under the order of any government or de facto authority or ruler, or any other act or failure to act of any local state or national government authority.
- Strike, sabotage, lockout, embargo, import restriction, port congestion, lack of usual means of public transportation and communication, industrial dispute, shipwreck, shortage of power supply epidemics, quarantine and plague.
- Earthquake, landslide, volcanic activity, fire flood or inundation, tidal wave, typhoon or cyclone, hurricane, nuclear and pressure waves or other natural or physical disaster.

If either party is prevented, hindered or delayed from or in performing any of its obligations under the Contract by an event of Force Majeure, then it shall notify the other in writing of the occurrence of such event and the circumstances of the event of Force Majeure within fourteen days after the occurrence of such event. The party who has given such notice shall be excused from the performance or punctual performance of its obligations under the Contract for so long as the relevant event of Force Majeure continues and to the extent that such party's performance is prevented, hindered or delayed.

The party or parties affected by the event of Force Majeure shall use reasonable efforts to mitigate the effect of the event of Force Majeure upto its or their performance of the Contract and to fulfill its or their obligation under the Contract but without prejudice to either party's right to terminate the Contract.

No delay or nonperformance by either party to this Contract caused by the occurrence of any event of Force Majeure shall.

• Constitute a default or breach of the contract.

• Give rise to any claim fro damages or additional cost or expense occurred by the delay or nonperformance. If, and to the extent, that such delay or nonperformance is caused by the occurrence of an event of Force Majeure.

31. INSURANCE COVERAGE

Appropriate insurance to cover all solution components for the transit period and until the time of its acceptance at the respective site is to be taken by the contractor. As the contractor will carry the risk for the material in his books during transit, the contractor should arrange insurance for the total system as period from the dispatch till Acceptance Test is successfully achieved. Further the contractor is to take all required insurance coverage in respect of all its personnel who shall be working on this engagement.

32. TENURE OF SERVICE CONTRACT

Three years service contract with renewal of yearly contract after review of service.

33. SERVICE SUPPORT & SLA

As per Section - Q

34. PERFORMANCE BANK GUARANTEE (PBG)

As a guarantee for timely delivery, installation and commissioning of equipment as well as performance of on-site warranty support, as mentioned in Bill of Material, from the date of final acceptance of systems and pertaining to proper running of the systems, the bidder will have to submit 10% of the contract value as security in the form of Performance Bank Guarantee from any nationalized bank as per format enclosed (Section – P).

35. SI/BIDDER/CONTRACTOR'S RESPONSIBILITIES

Refer Section - A (Scope of Work)

36. NO WAIVER OF RIGHTS

Neither the inspection by WTL or any of their agents nor any order by WTL for payment of money or any payment for or acceptance of the whole or any part of the works by WTL, nor any extension of time, nor any possession taken by WTL shall operate as a waiver of any provision of the contract or of any power reserved to WTL, or any right to damages here in provided, nor shall any waiver of any breach in the contract be held to be a waiver of any other subsequent breach.

37. GRAFTS, COMMISSIONS, GIFTS, ETC.

It is the Purchaser's policy to require that bidders, suppliers, contractors and consultants under contracts, observe the highest standard of ethics during the procurement and execution of such contracts. Any graft, commission, gift or advantage given, promised or offered by or on behalf of the contractor or his partner, agent, officers, director, employee or servant or any one on his or their behalf in relation to the obtaining or to the execution of this or any other contract with WTL shall in addition to any criminal liability which it may incur, subject the contractor to the cancellation of this and all other contracts and also to payment of any loss or damage to WTL resulting from any cancellation. WTL shall then be entitled to deduct the amount so payable from any monies otherwise due to the contractor under contract.

38. ENFORCEMENT OF TERMS

The failure of either party to enforce at any time any of the provision of this contract or any rights in respect thereto or to exercise any option here in provided shall in no way be construed to be a waiver to such provisions, rights or options or in any way to affect the validity of the contract. The exercise by either party of any of its rights herein shall not preclude or prejudice either party from exercising the same or any other right it may have hereunder.

39. PERIOD OF VALIDITY OF OFFER

For the purpose of placing the order, the proposals shall remain valid till 180 days. During the period of validity of proposals, the rates quoted shall not change. In exceptional circumstances, WTL may ask for extension of the period of validity and such a request shall be binding on Bidders. WTL's request and the response to such a request by various Bidders shall be in writing. A Bidder agreeing to such an extension will not be permitted to increase its rates.

40. TAXES & DUTIES

- The prices shall be inclusive of all taxes & levies including GST and other statutory duties as applicable. Rate of taxes should be indicated separately in the Price Bid.

43. LATE BID

Any proposal received by WTL after the deadline for submission of proposals may not be accepted.

44. OPENING OF BID BY WTL

Bids shall be opened and downloaded electronically through operation of the process in the e-Tender portal in presence of Tender Committee. Bidders interested to remain present during electronic bid opening may attend the bid opening session at WTL premises at scheduled date & time.

45. CONTACTING WTL

Bidder shall not approach WTL officers beyond office hours and/or outside WTL office premises from the time of the Bid opening to the time of finalization of successful bidder. Any effort by bidder to influence WTL office in the decision on Bid evaluation, Bid comparison or finalization may result in rejection of the Bidder's offer. If the bidder wishes to bring additional information to the notice of WTL, it should be in writing following the procedure mentioned hereinabove.

46. WTL'S RIGHT TO REJECT ANY OR ALL BIDS

WTL reserves the right to reject any bid and to annul the bidding process and reject all bids at any time prior to award of Contract, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder(s) or any obligation to inform the affected bidder(s) of the grounds for such decision.

47. BID CURRENCIES

Prices shall be quoted in Indian Rupees, inclusive of all prevailing GST, levies, duties, cess etc.

48. PRICE

- Price should be quoted in the Price Bid format only. No deviation in any form in the Price Bid sheet is acceptable.
- Price quoted should be firm, inclusive of packing, forwarding, insurance and freight charges.
- Percentage/specified amount of taxes & duties should be clearly mentioned otherwise WTL reserves the right to reject such vague offer.
- Price to be quoted inclusive of supply, installation & commissioning charges.

49. CANVASSING

Canvassing or support in any form for the acceptance of any tender is strictly prohibited. Any bidder doing so will render him liable to penalties, which may include removal of this name from the register of approved Contractors.

50. NON-TRANSFERABILITY OF TENDER

This tender document is not transferable.

51. FORMATS AND SIGNING OF BID

The original and all copies of the proposals shall be neatly typed and shall be signed by an authorized signatory(ies) on behalf of the Bidder. The authorization shall be provided by written Power of Attorney accompanying the proposal. All pages of the proposal, except for un-amended printed literature, shall be initialed by the person or persons signing the proposal. The proposal shall contain no interlineations, erase or overwriting. In order to correct errors made by the Bidder, all corrections shall be done & initialed with date by the authorized signatory after striking out the original words/figures completely.

52. WITHDRAWAL OF BID

Bid cannot be withdrawn during the interval between their submission and expiry of Bid's validity period. Fresh Bid may be called from eligible bidders for any additional item(s) of work not mentioned herein, if so required.

53. INTERPRETATION OF DOCUMENTS

If any bidder should find discrepancies or omission in the specifications or other tender documents, or if he should be in doubt as to the true meaning of any part thereof, he shall make a written request to the tender inviting authority for correction/clarification or interpretation or can put in a separate sheet along with his technical bid document.

55. PREPARATION OF TENDER

In case Line Item wise L2 bidder refuse to offer their service at the Line Item wise L1 evaluated price, and the process will go on until the one number of bidder other than bidder who originally offered Line Item wise L1 price are identified and selected. Two nos. links of each item are being considered for redundancy purpose. Line Item wise L1 bidder & second bidder will be considered for placement of order for one link (2Gbps & 50Mbps) at Line Item wise L1 price.

An affirmative Post Qualification determination will be prerequisite for award of the contract to the lowest quoted bidder. A negative determination will result in rejection of bidder's bid, in which event the WTL will proceed to the next lowest evaluated bidder to make a similar determination of that bidder's capability to perform satisfactorily. The successful bidder (s) will have to give security deposit in the form of Performance Bank Guarantee.

3. POST QUALIFICATION

The determination will evaluate the Bidder's financial, technical, design, integration, customization, production, management and support capabilities and will be based on an examination of the documentary evidence of the Bidder's qualification, as well as other information WTL deems necessary and appropriate. This determination may include visits or interviews with the Bidder's client's reference in its bid, site inspection, and any other measures. At the time of post-qualification, Directorate of Commercial Taxes may also carry out tests to determine that the performance or functionality of the Information System offered meets those stated in the detailed Technical Specification.

 - If latency of any link is more than what is specified in SLA for continuous 30minutes during normal business hours then financial penalty would be applicable to the tune of Rs.500/- per hour for higher latency.

MTTR will not be calculated in EBH except for data centre.

MTTR will be allowed only for two downtime events for each location in a month.

As business critical applications will be running on the Customer's Network, any extended downtime as mentioned below will severely affect customer's business causing substantial financial and reputation loss. Therefore, to avoid such losses, the successful bidder should take adequate steps to deliver the desired uptime. The customer will have periodical review of the availability/performance of links. If the links are down continuously for a longer time or non-fulfillment of various parameters in functioning of links, the customer may terminate the contract fully or partly, if required.

Other Contractual Obligations of the Successful Bidder

The following are the general terms and conditions proposed to be included in the Contract.

- 1. Wherever contractual arrangements are necessary, it will be the sole responsibility of the Successful Bidder to make all necessary contractual arrangements across all components of the solution.
- 2. All equipments and services to be supplied by the successful bidder in response to this Tender and under the resultant contract must be eligible for export to India for use as per the contract, under the existing regulations of the country(s) of origin.
- 3. Network equipments required for the links, at two locations for all types of last mile connectivity other than Routers should be supplied and maintained by the successful bidder. The necessary Data cabling, Electrical cabling, and all other infrastructure required for the connectivity upto the Router / LAN segment of the location should be provided by the bidder.
- 4. The bidder should provide and ensure adequate protection for their network equipments against contingencies like heavy rains, wind, monkey attacks etc. The bidder should factor such local factors and provide necessary protection like platform/monkey cages/snow shield, wherever necessary, without any additional cost. Cost required for these provisioning may be included in the project cost.

To complete this job, the Successful Bidder should arrange for the required labour and other materials on his own.

- 5. All the specifications and other related literature & information, provided by the Service Provider as agreed, will also form a part of the agreement.
- 6. The bill of material containing item-wise details in respect of Supply & Maintenance of Bandwidth by the Successful Bidder, must be furnished along with the prices thereof, in the commercial bid and as per the terms and conditions contained in this document.
- 7. The successful bidder will abide by the job safety, insurance, customs and immigration measures prevalent and the laws in force in India, and will indemnify the Customer against all demands or responsibilities arising from accidents or loss of life, the cause of which is the Successful Bidder's negligence. The Successful Bidder will pay all indemnities arising from such incidents and will not hold the Customer responsible or obligated.
- 8. The Successful Bidder shall be responsible for, and obligated to conduct all contracted activities with due care and diligence, in accordance with the Contract and using state-of-the-art methods and economic principles, and exercising all reasonable means to achieve the performance specified in the Contract.
- 9. The Successful Bidder shall work closely with the customer's staff, act within its own authority, and abide by directives issued by the Customer that are consistent with the terms of the Contract.
- 10. The Successful Bidder shall be responsible for managing the activities of its personnel and any subcontracted personnel, and will hold itself responsible for any misdemeanours/loss/expenses.
- 11. The Successful Bidder shall appoint an experienced Representative to manage its performance of the Contract. The Representative shall be authorized to accept orders and notices on behalf of the Successful Bidder, and to generate notices and commit the Successful Bidder to specific courses of action within the scope of the Contract. The Representative may be replaced only with the prior written consent of the Customer. The Successful Bidder shall be solely responsible for the performance of the contract to the satisfaction of the Customer.
- 12. **Site Visits:** Site visits may be sought at the discretion of the Customer. Bidders shall arrange for visits to customer sites/Bidder's own NOC/PoP/any other office/location at their own cost.
